ULFA rejects safe passage offer

GUWAHATI, India, Nov 7 : The main separatist rebel group in the troubled far-eastern Indian state of Assam has rejected a government offer of safe passage for its leaders living in exile, reports said today.

The outlawed United Liberation Front of Assam (ULFA), fighting for the state's independence, said the government should stop playing games and announce a plebiscite on the issue of Assam's separation from India.

Paresh Barua, a ULFA leader in exile, was quoted by local newspapers as saying that the

10-day offer of safe passage into India, due to come into force from December 10, was not acceptable.

"Instead of playing such childish games, the government should initiate steps to hold a plebiscite on the issue of Assam's sovereignty.

Barua, speaking from an undisclosed location abroad, said the ULFA would give up its armed struggle "if the people of Assam gave their verdict against our demand."

Assam chief minister Prafulla Mahanta, while announcing the details of the safe passage offer last week, said:

"The ultras can visit their parents with our knowledge and without carrying any weapons within the state."

Mahanta said the offer was aimed at enabling the militants to hold peace talks with the government, if they chose to do so.

Late last month Assam Governor Siba Prasad Mukherjee said that the ULFA rebels following requests made by several members of the group.

Obituary

Dr Hamiduddin Khan, a retired professor of Law Department of Dhaka University, died of lung cancer at Dhaka Central Hospital at 4 am yesterday. He was 75, reports UNB.

Dr Khan left behind his wife, three sons, three daughters and a large number of admirers.

Born on March 1, 1925, in Kishoreganj, Dr Khan secured first class first in LLB from Dhaka University in 1964. He joined as teacher in the university the same year and finally retired from teaching in 1995 after 10 years' extension. He did his doctorate from London in 1972.

The *namaz-e-janaza* of Dr Khan was held at Dhaka University Central Mosque after Zohr prayers. His body was taken to his village home to be buried at his family graveyard.

His *qulhwani* will be held on Thursday after Asr prayers at his residence at 265, Kataban.

ME peace process monitoring
Mandela calls for creation of int'l commission

JOHANNESBURG, Nov 7 : South African former president Nelson Mandela today called for the creation of an international commission to oversee the Middle East peace process, reports AFP.

In an interview with SABC public television, the elder statesman said the proposed commission should work with the United Nations and comprise members nominated by stakeholders in the Middle East.

It will be necessary, for example, to say to the Arab countries: Who do you want to be in this commission? and then to say the same things to the Israelis," Mandela said.

"(The proposed commission) can never carry the confidence of the parties in the dispute if they do not have confidence in the people who form this international commission," he said.

Mandela said the commission would form part of a three-point peace plan for the Middle East which he proposed during a five-day visit to the region last month — his most high-profile diplomatic mission since stepping down in June.

Also under the plan, Israel would have to withdraw from all territories occupied during the 1967 six-day war with its Arab neighbours and in return Arab states would recognise the sovereignty of Israel.

Lastly, the commission should oversee decisions on the status of Jerusalem and that of Palestinian refugees, the boundaries of the Palestinian state and the future of Jewish settlers on the West Bank.

Perestroika reforms led to fall of Berlin Wall: Gorbachev

MADRID, Nov 7 : Former Soviet president Mikhail Gorbachev claimed his perestroika reforms led to the fall of the Berlin Wall, Madrid daily El Pais reported today, reports AFP.

In an interview published to mark the 10th anniversary of the fall of the Wall on November 9, Gorbachev claimed the fundamental reform and democratisation process he launched in the former Soviet Union inspired revolution in East bloc countries, leading to the dismantling of the Wall and German reunification.

"Without the changes taking place in Russia there would have been no free elections in the Warsaw Pact countries. Without perestroika, there would have been no Velvet Revolution and the Germans would not have demonstrated against the Honecker regime," Gorbachev claimed.

Gorbachev said that while no one in autumn 1989 thought German reunification would happen before the end of the century, he, Kohl and Bush decided then that we had to do what the Germans were asking

and so we changed our policies." Gorbachev said that Western counterparts later decided to take advantage of the breakup of the former Soviet Union.
