

Long-time occupation of 'mooring buoys' seen vital reason

Unloading of foodgrains hampered at Mongla Port

KHULNA, Nov 20: Months long occupation of important mooring buoys by at least eight vessels, unloading of food grains imported under USAID and World Food Programme is seriously hampered at the Mongla Port, reports UNB.

According to port officials, MV Delos-1 with 13,000 tons wheat and MV Arcadia with 14,000 tons wheat are waiting at the outer anchorage for the last 10 days. At present seven vessels carrying foodgrains are at the port and five of them are waiting in the outer anchorage under compulsion.

MV Vishu Kumudi, an Indian flag carrier, arrived with 8323 tons rice on March 31 last from India under emergency import by the government. The authorities arrested the ship when it was found that the rice is unfit for human consumption. Since then the ship is in the port.

MV Great Universe, a

Panama flag vessel carrying 10,000 tons fertilizer, arrived at the port on June 1 and completed its discharge by the same month and was also arrested by the Marine Court and staying in the port since then.

MV Tarpsichore, a Malta flag vessel carrying 15,000 tons cement arrived at the port on May 1 last, discharged its cargo on time but was arrested for complication of validity documents.

MV Everise Glory, a Malaysian flag vessel carrying 12,000 tons cement arrived on August 23 last, completed its discharge before September 31 but was held in the port.

Similarly MV Shonchong Gang of DPRK, Sipros C of Cypriot, Sumsel of Panama are staying at the port.

The Department of Mercantile Marine had ordered the port authority to arrest or not to give port clearance to

those ships as its papers expired validity.

A highly placed source in the port however said that the consignees adopting 'fraudulent' means filed cases in the MMD and managed order in favour of them just to realize money from the ship owners.

Owing to this the port is compelled to keep the ships for months together occupying important mooring buoys and hampering the operation of the port.

A section of port officials are allegedly also collaborating with the consignees and as such the Food Department is facing a lot of problems.

The government had to pay for the delay of the vessels came under WFP and USAID. US dollar 7000/8000 demurrage per day. Moreover, Harbour Department keeps the vessels in such a place where it is not safe
