German-funded NGOs change face of rural communities

COX'S BAZAR, Nov 21: German-funded development efforts in Cox's Bazar region, based on cooperative understanding and participatory approach, are enabling thousands of the poor to get rid of poverty and be socially conscious, reports BSS.

The uplift efforts through three NGOs have changed the face of the rural communities in the remote areas of Sadar, Moheshkhali, Ukhiya, Ramu and Teknaf thanas of the district.

Advisor of the three NGOs, Father Klaus Beurle, told BSS that the NGOs - Bangla-German Sampreeti (BGS), Tarango, Anando - put their all-out efforts to fight a range of challenges including unemployment, low literacy rate, malnutrition and inadequate health and sanitation of the rural communities.

The beneficiaries of BGS actions are marginal farmers, day-labourers, street boys and widows. Anando provides need-based technical training to the rural unemployed youth and Tarango provides training on handicrafts for the poor women.

Anando also runs a cultural unit in rural areas to promote the cultural tradition of the tribal communities.

BGS has already constructed 4,732 low-cost houses for the poor, 25 community institutions, four cyclone shelters, 3,474 sanitation latrines, two girls' hostels, and 50 nursery schools. It also provided micro-credit for 4,269 people and medical care for 5,000 families.

Khurshida, 30, a teacher of BGS nursery school, said dropout rate in the school is very low as teachers rush to their students' houses to bring them back when they stop coming to school.

"The teaching job not only brings me a livelihood, but also awards me social status and respect in society," she said.

Treasury bills auction held

The 63rd auction of the 28-day, 91-day, 182-day, 364-day, 2-year and 5-year treasury bills were held in the city yesterday, reports UNB.

A total of Tk 684.50 crore, Tk 25.50 crore, Tk 87.50 crore, Tk 77.00 crore and Tk 40.00 crore were offered respectively for the 28-day, 91-day, 182-day, 364-day and 2-year bills.

Of these, Tk 649.60 crore, Tk 11.50 crore, Tk 35.00 crore and Tk 12.00 crore were accepted respectively against the bills with the range of implicit yields of 6.45-6.85 per cent, 7.67-7.70 per cent, 8.10-8.15 per cent and 8.90 per cent per annum.

Bids offered for the 91-day bill were not accepted and no bid was offered for the 5-year bill.

A five-day long children's painting exhibition is going to be held in the cafeteria of Alliance Francaise de Dhaka from Dec 3, says a press release.

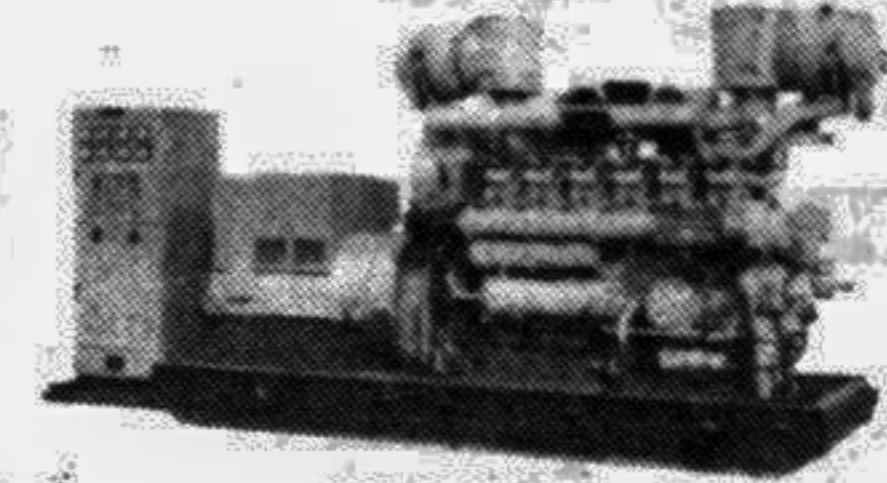
