TELEVISION JOURNALISM

The Thomson Foundation of UK, in co-operation with the Bangladesh Centre for Development, Journalism and Communication (BCDJC) and the Family Planning Association of Bangladesh, will be running a training course for television journalists and camera-operators in February 2000. There are only 12 openings in this 3-week course that will be conducted in English.

The course is linked to a national campaign to heighten health awareness among Bangladeshi adolescents. Those who gain a place may be offered to work on a television series following the training course.

Requirements

Journalist places: Applicants are expected to have some journalism or communication experience in electronic or print media. Apart from journalists, those working with Non-Governmental Organisations concerned with health matters but who are interested in television journalism will also be considered.

Camera-operator places: Applicants are expected to be proficient in the use of a video camera (VHS, S-VHS, BETA, DVCA) but need not have worked as a professional TV camera-operator. This is a course for those who already have the basic skills but wish to develop them for work in broadcast television.




Chhayanaut classes resume Dec 3
