**JCD activist beaten up**

He was identified as Monir, a third year student of Islamic Studies department, and resident of the hall.

A group of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) workers beat him up at about 12 noon and forced him to leave the dormitory, hall sources said.

**Baktaboli Day observed**

NARAYANGANJ, Nov 29: Speakers at a memorial meeting paid tributes to 139 villagers who were brutally killed by Pakistani forces at Baktaboli village under Fatullah Police Station on November 29, 1971, reports BSS.

Organised jointly by Fatullah and Baktaboli union Awami League, the memorial meeting was presided over by Ibrahim Proshan, President Baktaboli Union Awami League.

The villagers were gunned down at Baktaboli on the banks of the rivers Dhaleswari and Buriganga only 16 days before the country was liberated from the occupation forces. Fifteen villagers were also burnt in the carnage by the Pakistani Army.

Milad mahfil, special prayers and discussion meetings were also held to mark the day, known as Baktaboli Day.

The speakers urged the people to uphold the spirit of the war of liberation.

**Qatar envoy presents credentials**

Newly appointed Ambassador of Qatar Abdullah S Mohammad Al-Mana presented his credentials to President Shahabuddin Ahmed at Bangabhaban yesterday, report agencies.

Welcoming Al-Mana, President Shahabuddin said relations between Bangladesh and Qatar are built on strong foundations.

He said both the countries cooperate closely on matters of mutual interest in organisations such as the United Nations and the OIC. As members of the Islamic Ummah, Bangladesh and Qatar share a common heritage, he observed.

**New courses at British Council**

**Chinese team calls on Shahabuddin**

A six-member delegation of the Supreme People's Procuratorate of China called on President Shahabuddin Ahmed at Bangabhaban yesterday and discussed judicial matters of the two countries, reports UNB.

Deputy Procurator General of the SPCC Liang Guoqing led the delegation.

Welcoming the visitors, the President said their visit would help strengthen the existing Sino-Bangladesh relations.

Terming the bilateral relations 'very good and friendly', Shahabuddin stressed the need for exchange of ideas in judicial matters between the two countries.

Attorney General Mahmudul Islam apprised the President in the meeting that an agreement between Bangladesh and China relating to cooperation in judicial affairs was signed yesterday.

Liang Guoqing expressed his satisfaction over the existing judicial system in Bangladesh.

Present, among others, were Procurator General Li Gen Shi Jizhou, Procurator General Zhang Xuejun, Director General Ye Feng, Chinese Ambassador in Dhaka Wang Chungui, Deputy Attorney General AKM Shafiquddin and Assistant Attorney General Obaidul Hassan Shaheen.

**\$500,000 German grant for CHT dev projects**

Germany will provide US dollar 500,000 for the socio-economic development of Chittagong Hill Tracts, reports BSS.
