Transmission of Bangladesh Television (BTV) will soon be turned into digital from current analog system, State Minister for Information Prof Abu Sayeed said yesterday in a press briefing, reports BSS.

The matter was settled in the 2nd International Conference and Europe Asia-Pacific Dialogue on Public Service Broadcasting held late last month in Manila. Prof Abu Sayeed attended the three-day conference that began in Quezon city on November 29.

Talking to journalists in the conference room of the Ministry of Information Prof. Sayeed said digital transmission is likely to be operational in March or at the latest in April next year.

The state minister said once converted from analog to digital the BTV transmission would be much better and the state-
