Mehmud magic continues

Shahed Mehmud continued his magic run in the National Cricket League as leaders Chittagong got off to a confident start in their seventh round clash against hosts Khulna at the Jessoro Stadium yesterday.

On the first day of the three-day match, the Pakistani leg-spinner, who captured the spotlight by snaring 32 wickets in only his three-match appearances, once again returned with a four-wicket haul to shoot out Khulna for 159 in 64.2 overs. Earlier, the hosts won the toss and elected to bat.

The Lahore-based leggie of Chittagong conceded 74 runs in 26 overs. Right arm medium pacer Zakir Hossain, who took two wickets for 23 runs, ably helped him to ensure the Khulna collapse.

Khulna's middle-order batsman Asadullah Khan fought a lone battle against the niggling attack of the visitors. He scored 51 off 88 balls that included a sixer and three fours.

Apart from Asadullah, none of the home side batsmen could reach twenty.

In reply, the visitors moved on to take the advantage scoring 90 for 1 at a close.
