Ayesha Hanif and Anurup Aich two designers started an exquisite exhibition of fashion wear and household items at the Alliance Francaise on October 17 with eminent writer Anisul Haq inaugurating the exhibition. They have in their collection panjabis and salwar-kameezes saris, T-shirts and handicrafts.

Panjabis are the cynosure of the exhibition. The specialties are 'Tribal Hill Check' and designs inspired by 'Islamic calligraphy'. The calligraphic motifs have added a new dimension in panjabi designing. The collection looks quite attractive and the prices are very

## Firoz Wins Elizabeth Greenshields Award


