South Melbourne
vow to surprise

SYDNEY, Dec 29: South Melbourne coach Ange Postecoglou believes his team of underdogs can upset some of the high-flyers at next month's world club championship in Brazil, reports AFP.

Postecoglou and his Greek-backed team head to Sao Paulo to meet Vasco da Gama (Brazil), Necaxa (Mexico) and English and European champions Manchester United in their group of the inaugural world club title.

"I can't see any reason why we can't pull off a surprise," Postecoglou said Wednesday.

"We'll do as good a job as any other team from Australia would have done."

Postecoglou said his side would not be overawed and had done their research for the elite world championship.

"Manchester United has been easier to keep track of on tapes. I've watched some videos of Vasco but Necaxa has been hard to find," he said.

"Since I've been in charge of South Melbourne, we've been very much the hunted as the top team here after back-to-back preishis," he said.

"There has been pressure we in and wek out but I'm now going to a tournament without his type of pressure."

"If anything, we have the ability to surprise and if they underestimate us, we can use that to our advantage."

"It's a once in a lifetime opportunity and I will come back as a better coach and with a better team."

Kewell Oceania's
player of the year

SYDNEY, Dec 29: Australian midfielder Harry Kewell has been named the Oceania player of the year, reports AFP.

Kewell, an influential member of the youthful Leeds United team in the English Premier League, was an overwhelming winner of the award voted by regional football writers.

The 21-year-old is widely regarded as the greatest soccer talent Australia has produced.

The award follows a year when Kewell was involved in a club versus country battle between Australia and Leeds for his services.

His no-show for the two-match home series against Brazil's Olympic side in November led to Soccer Australia successfully seeking a FIFA ban on Kewell playing for Leeds in a Premiership match.

Kewell, looked on as an integral part of Australia's campaign for qualification for the 2002 World Cup finals in Japan and South Korea, received 115 votes, outpolling Glasgow Celtic striker Mark Viduka (69) and Munich 1860 midfielder Ned Zeljic (37) for the 1999 Oceania award.

He also beat past award winners, Mark Bosnich and Christian Karembeu.

Haas a pacifist

BERLIN, Dec 29: German tennis player Tommy Haas has told German weekly Bunte he does not want to be considered for military service in the German army, reports AFP.

Twenty-one-year-old Haas said in the issue that his conscience prevented him from accepting the call-up -- national service is compulsory in Germany.

AFP FOOTBALL BRIEFS

ROME, Dec 29 (AFP): Italian Serie A club Roma are negotiating with Perugia in a bid to sign Japanese playmaker Hidetoshi Nakata, sources at both clubs said Wednesday.

Roma, who were gazzumped by Inter Milan recently when they attempted to buy Real Madrid's Dutch international Clarence Seedorf, have now earmarked Nakata as the man to strengthen their title challenge.

Roma merely confirmed: "The negotiations are at a delicate stage."

Meanwhile, Perugia chairman Luciano Gaucci said: "I must act in the interests of my team. The deal could be done with an exchange."

The fee is believed to be in the vicinity of 6.2 million dollars with Roma prepared to part company with Russian Dmitri Alenichev, Belarus Sergei Gurenko or Yugoslav Ivan Tomic as part of the deal. Even Roma's Brazilian Fabio Junior has been named as a possible mackeweight.

Nakata is a hero at Perugia - last season he was linked with Manchester United - and the club will demand a high price for him.

Gaucci said: "My player has been spoken about a lot and the

interest in him did not begin yesterday."

However, other Serie A teams such as champions AC Milan are believed to be also monitoring Nakata, who joined Perugia in 1998 from Japanese outfit Bellmare Hiratsuka.

The diminutive star, who played for his country in the 1998 World Cup in France, has been a big hit at Perugia and has scored 10 goals in 33 matches. So popular is he in his homeland that Perugia's attendances are often swollen by parties of tourists from Japan.

MIJAC QUILTS LIEGE

BRUSSELS: Croatian coach Zeljko Mijac has resigned as coach to Belgian First Division team Standard Liege after the club refused to give him a permanent deal following a mediocre run, Belgian press agency Belga reported Wednesday.

Mijac had succeeded Tomislav Ivic as Liege coach in September but had not done enough to convince the board he deserved a permanent contract.

The person concerned (Mijac) preferred to quit his first team duties to consecrate himself exclusively to the reserve and youth teams at Standard," the club said.

Mijac is the seventh coach to leave his post in the Belgian First Division this season.

Belgian Jean Thissen, who was Mijac's assistant, is being tipped to take over the job, initially on a six-month contract.

Standard Liege are in eighth spot in the Belgian First Division and have reached the Belgian Cup quarter-finals.

SCHMEICHEL NOW
A CLUB OWNER

COPENHAGEN: Danish national team goalkeeper Peter Schmeichel, currently with Portuguese First Division side Sporting Lisbon, has bought Danish Second Division club Hvidovre Fodbold A/S, the Copenhagen suburban club said Wednesday.

"Peter has taken control of the club's two semi-professional clubs (one in the Second Division and the reserve team in Serie A, and a group of 35 players," a club spokesman told AFP.

The spokesman would give no further details but a press conference beginning at 13:30 GMT has been called for later Wednesday.

Hvidovre was founded in 1925 and the entire sporting body of the business comprises 40 teams of which 38 are amateur and a playing staff of

around 700.

Schmeichel, in his prime widely considered the best goalkeeper in the world, is arguably the most famous Danish footballer in history having kept goal when the national team won the 1992 European Championships.

He had a glittering career with English giants Manchester United and brought down the curtain on his career with that club last season by winning the Treble of the European Cup, English FA Cup and English Premiership.

PIRES HAVING SECOND
THOUGHTS

PARIS: French World Cup winner Robert Pires admits he is worried that a move to English Premiership side Arsenal might scupper his chances of representing France in Euro 2000, French paper L'Equipe reported Wednesday.

Marseille playmaker Pires is one of several players at the south coast club wrestling with the decision whether to part company with the French First Division outfit after being harassed by the club's notoriously volatile fans in recent weeks.

Pires is one of the players who bore the brunt of the anger of the fans who wrecked cars and jostled players after their club's recent poor form but the France 98 star believes the time it would take him to adapt to life in England could cost him at national level.

Pires, 26, told L'Equipe: "I am much in demand but I am also thinking a lot of Euro 2000."

"The approaches (from Arsenal) exist as they do with other clubs. But once more what matters is Euro (2000). I do not want to burn my bridges and it seems to me that to go abroad now would be to do so."

Pires was a member of Aime Jacquet's World Cup winning squad, although his appearances were fleeting, and many saw him then as the outstanding future prospect in French football. However, under Jacquet's successor Roger Lemerre Pires is yet to make a first-team place his own.

Inter rope in
Cordoba

ROME, Dec 29: Colombian international Ivan Ramiro Cordoba has joined Inter Milan, the Italian Serie A club reported Tuesday, reports AFP.

The 23-year-old defender will kick his first ball in anger for his new club on January 6.

At a press conference in Cordoba, who has moved from Argentina's division one side San Lorenzo Almagro, said: "I know the reputation of Roberto Baggio, Ronaldo, Ivan Zamorano, Christian Panucci."

Cordoba's arrival comes just days after the transfer to Inter from Real Madrid of the Dutch international Clarence Seedorf.

"We can have our say in the championship with these players. Seedorf will give us an extra boost in attack and midfield while Cordoba reinforces our defence," said Inter's coach Marcello Lippi.

Inter Milan are lying sixth, eight points off pacesetters Lazio in the Italian First Division.

No room for
Zambians

LUSAKA, Dec 29 (Reuters): Zambia's soccer team have been refused entry to a hotel for unpaid bills, three weeks before the African Nations Cup finals start in Nigeria and Ghana.

The team, which cut short a training trip to North and Central America two weeks ago complaining of poor accommodation and food, hit more problems when they reassembled for a training camp at home in Ndola.

Newspaper reports say the management of Ndola's Savoy Hotel refused to take in the players or feed them.

"They owe us money and we are expected to take them in when they come back empty-handed. Is that fair?" The Times of Zambia quoted a hotel official as asking.

Another newspaper, The Post, said the team went hungry the whole of Monday and later decided to move their training camp to the Zambian capital Lusaka.

Eriksson's
assurance for
Rivaldo

ROME, Dec 29: Lazio coach Sven Goran Eriksson assured European footballer of the year Rivaldo on Tuesday he would be welcome at the Rome club if he left Barcelona, reports Reuters.

"Rivaldo? If he were to show up here at Formello we'd find a place for him without any problem," Eriksson told reporters at Lazio's Formello training ground. "Who wouldn't want Rivaldo in their squad?"

Lazio have been linked with Rivaldo since the Brazilian forward had a fall-out over tactics with Barcelona coach Louis van Gaal and was dropped from the Catalan side's first team.

Gazzetta dello Sport newspaper reported a week ago that Lazio were ready to pay a world record 120 billion lire (62.53 million dollars) to bring Rivaldo to Rome when the Italian winter transfer window opens on January 4.

Corriere dello Sport said this week that Lazio president Sergio Cragnotti was trying to arrange a meeting with Rivaldo's agent Jose Maria Minguelia early in the New Year.

Morocco rule Africa



JOHANNESBURG, Dec 29: The Moroccan national football team ended the year where they began it -- on top of the monthly African rankings compiled by world governing body FIFA, reports AFP.

Morocco were unbeaten against African opposition during 1999 under French coach Henri Michel and achieved a notable 2-1 friendly triumph away to Euro 2000 co-hosts Holland.

Michel has built his team around Europe-based players, including defensive kingpin Noureddine Naybet, midfielders Youssef Chippo and Mustapha Hadji and striker Salaheddine Bassir.

The Atlas Lions face co-hosts Nigeria, Tunisia and Congo in the Group of Death at the African Nations Cup finals next month as they seek to translate statistical superiority into silverware.

South Africa, Tunisia, Zambia, Egypt, Ghana, Cote d'Ivoire, Cameroon and the

Democratic Republic of Congo also started and finished the year among the top 10 African football nations.

Angola were the only newcomers, rising from 11th position to seventh thanks to a successful Castle Cup Southern Africa championship campaign that ended in a 2-1 aggregate victory over Namibia.

While the Black Panthers climbed, the Nigeria Super Eagles fell, slipping five places to 15th because of minimal activity and some disappointing friendly scorelines.

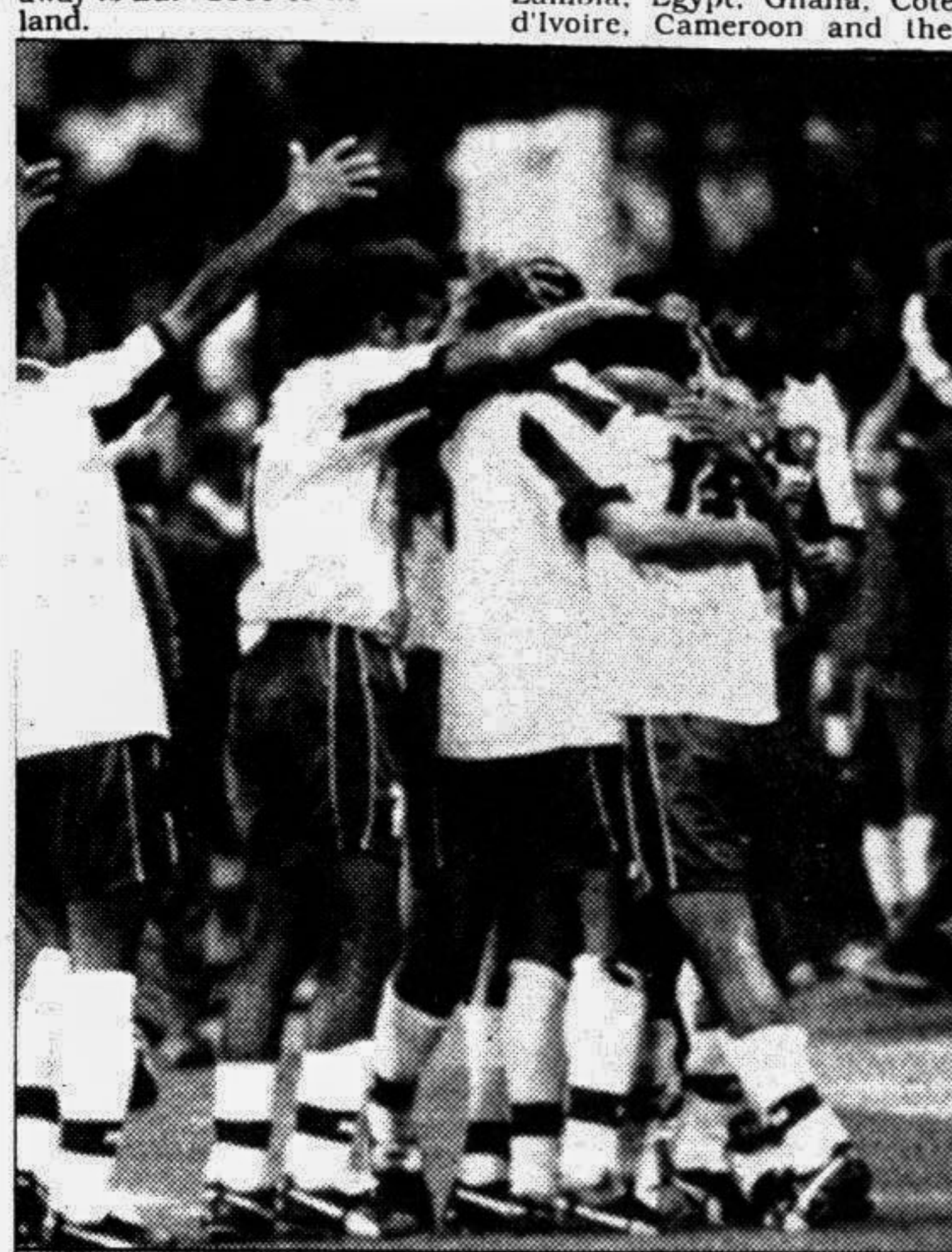
Minnows Libya were voted the Best Movers by FIFA as they rose 10 places to 31st, a feat matched by surprise Castle Cup semi-finalists Swaziland. Burkina Faso and Rwanda rose seven places.

The Central African Republic and Mauritius jumped six positions and 2000 African Nations Cup qualifiers Congo Brazzaville and Senegal climbed five places.

Guinea suffered the sharpest slump, dropping eight notches to 20th, followed by other West African countries Togo (down seven) and Niger (down six).

Anna eying Gold Coast title



GOLD COAST, Australia, Dec 29: Russian tennis star Anna Kournikova says her serving woes won't resurface in Australia this summer as she strives for her first tournament win, reports AFP.

Kournikova has one of her best chances to break the title drought when she lines up as second seed in the Australian Women's Hardcourt Championships starting here on Sunday.

It will be the first time 18-year-old Kournikova has played here since wobbling through her Australian Open campaign in Melbourne last year, hiccupping to 31 double faults in one infamous match.

But Kournikova barely flinched at a press conference Wednesday when asked whether she would return.

"No, if you saw my last tournaments, I didn't see any problems," Kournikova is full of confidence after completing a solid end to 1999, including an intense last month on the practice

court. She reached the fourth round of three grand slam tournaments this year, including Wimbledon and the French Open, while claiming her first major doubles title with Martina Hingis at the Australian Open.

But Kournikova was reluctant to list goals for 2000, even though the inevitable question surfaced about her hopes of winning a tournament.

"To do so next week she must overcome Julie Halard-Decugis, Conchita Martinez and Arantxa Sanchez-Vicario."

"We'll see. I can't just say that tomorrow I'm going to be number one," Kournikova said.

"You never know what can happen. I'll say that right now I'm working hard and I'll take it one day at a time and improve with each practice and each match."

"I have to be focused, which I'm doing now, and hopefully it will come."

Kournikova practised Wednesday showing some signs of a virus.

But she insisted she was almost over the illness and would be ready for her first singles match next Wednesday after receiving a first round bye.

"The first day (in Australia) is always difficult but I'll just try and get used to the atmosphere in the next few days," she said.
