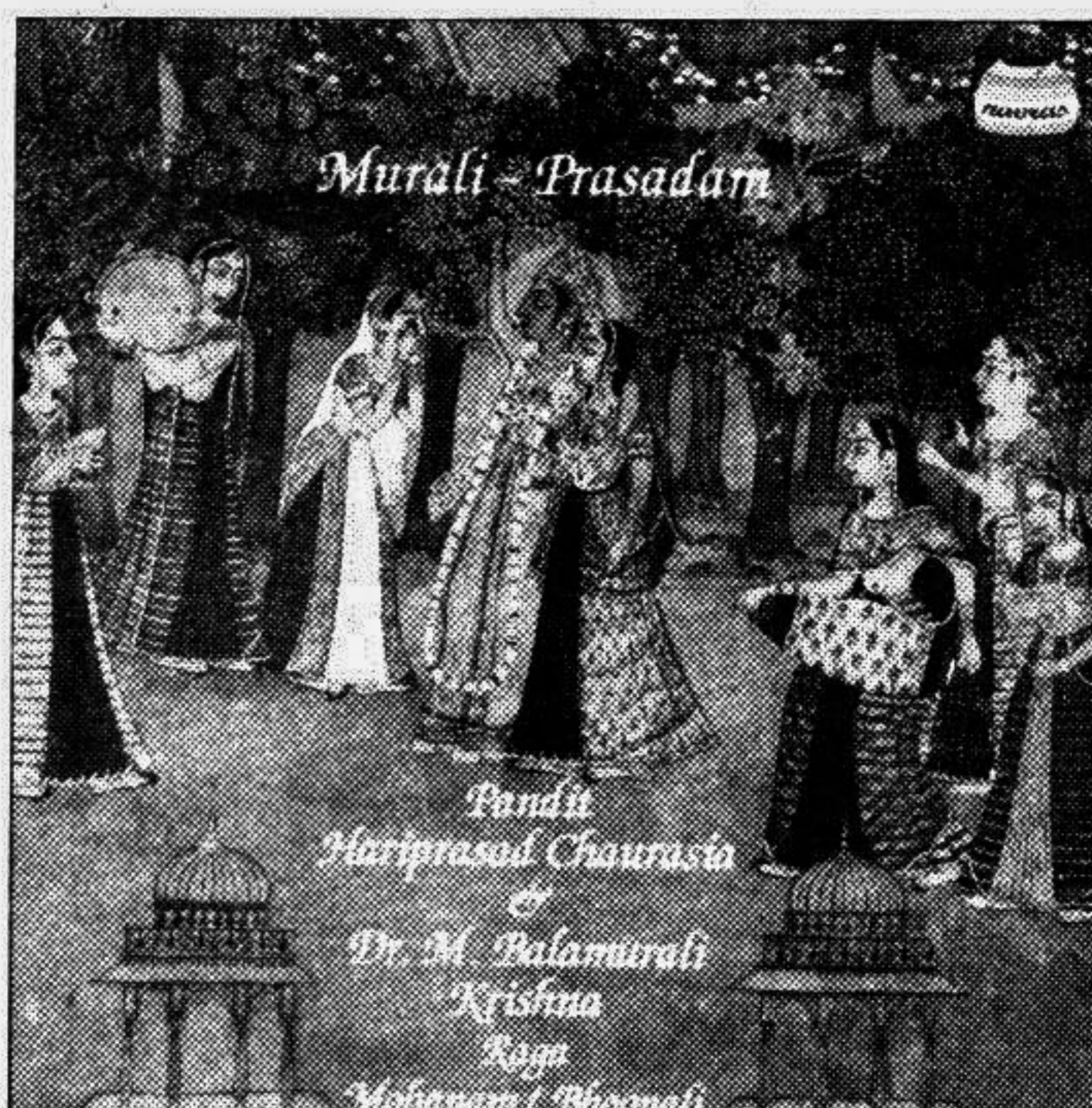

The Hindustani and Carnatic systems of music are thought to have diverged from a common source around 400 years ago. Today they present a fascinating and subtle contrast, being so similar in their underlying principles and yet so unmistakably distinct. The southern, Carnatic system, relies more on composition and on the codification of rag and tal structures; the northern Hindustani system, placing more reliance on improvisation, emphasises the importance of subtleties of rag-structure in creating particular moods. A number of rags have been exchanged between the two systems, as have other features such as rhythmic variation techniques. Despite this, they remain very much independent systems.

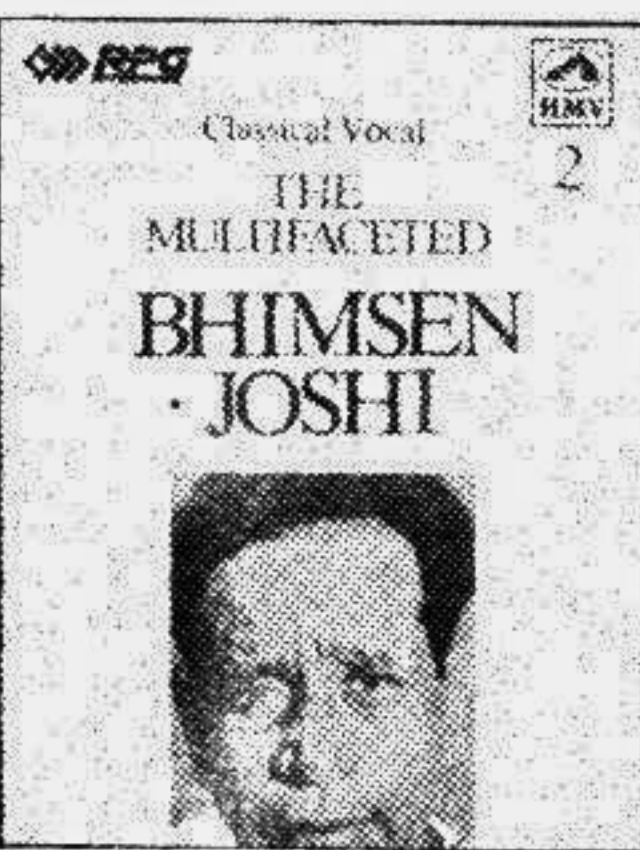

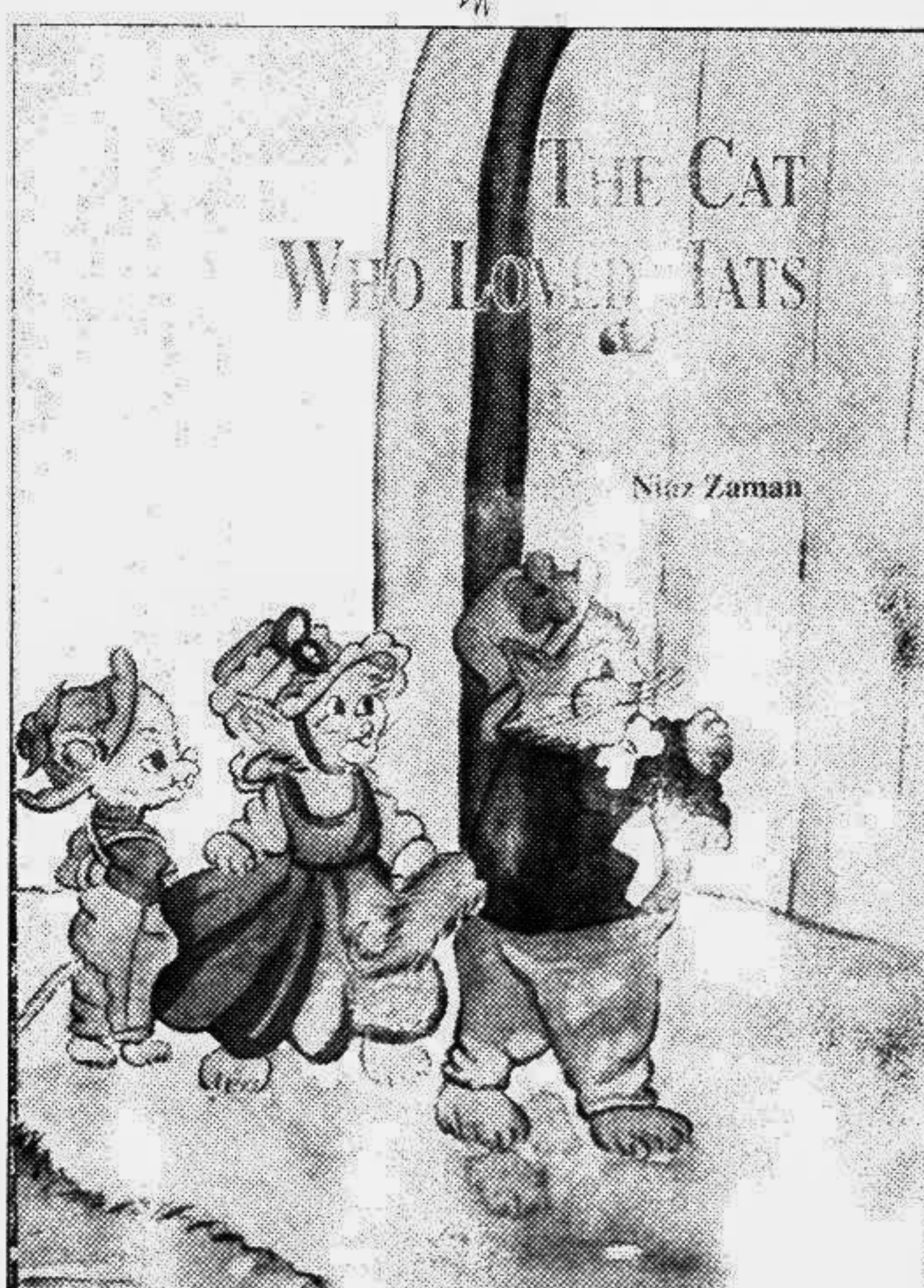

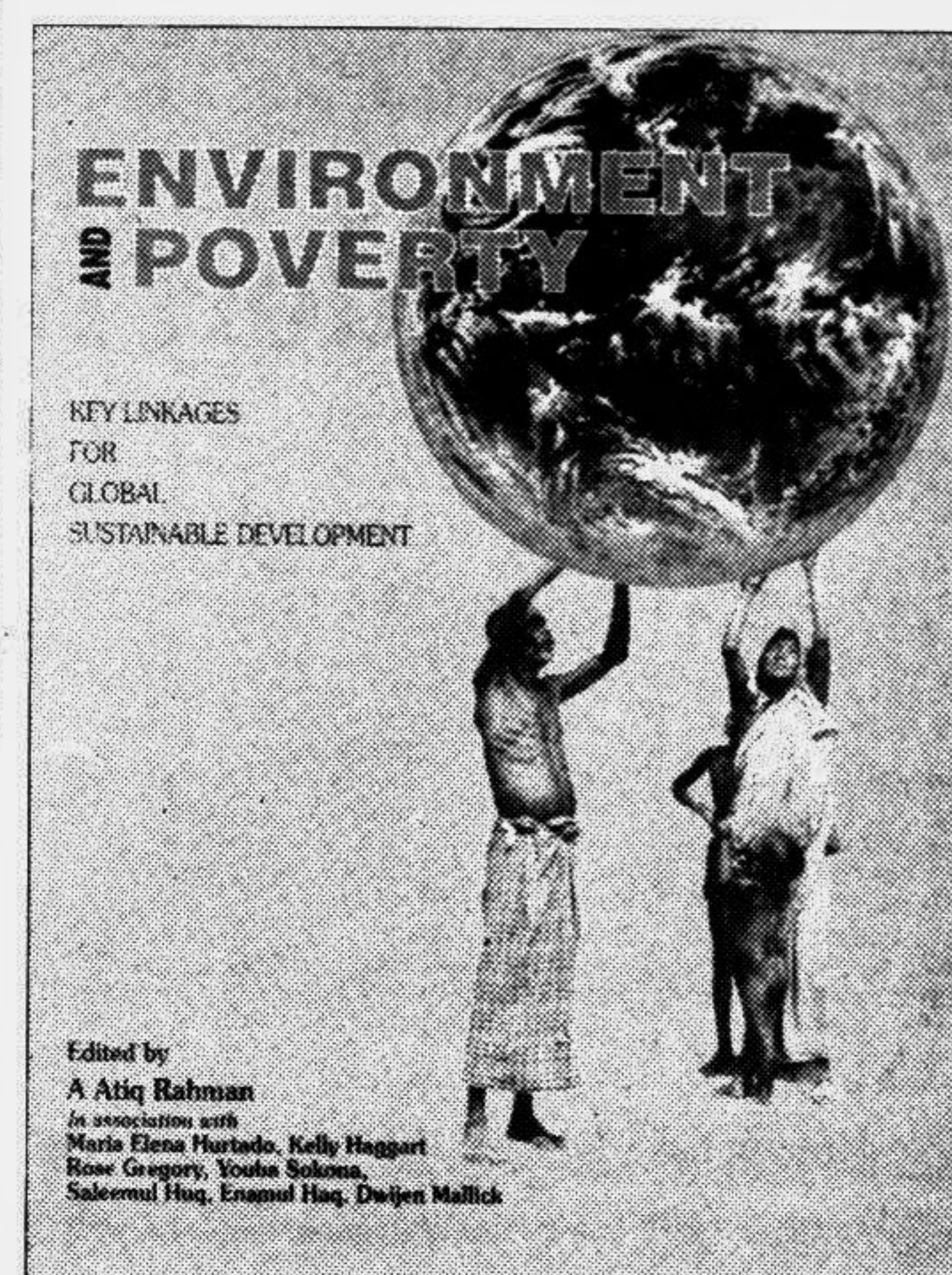

This book emerged out of the Special English programme at Holy Cross School. Holy Cross is a Bangla Medium School, and Sister Joann, who was then the Principal, hoped that this programme would expose students to English through fun and games. During the first few months of coordinating the programme, I realized that rather than their school text, most of the elementary school children did not have one single English book at home. I didn't want to use the English readers commonly used in English medium schools. What could I use for reading material? It was while thinking of a solution, that the idea of Dr Seuss's Cat in the Hat struck me. Elementary school children learn a-b, b-a-t, c-a-t, and believed that they could use this knowledge to read The Cat Who Loves Hats on their own. I used part of this material with students of class 1 and they enjoyed it. They wanted the whole story, but I told them they would have to wait until the book was published. 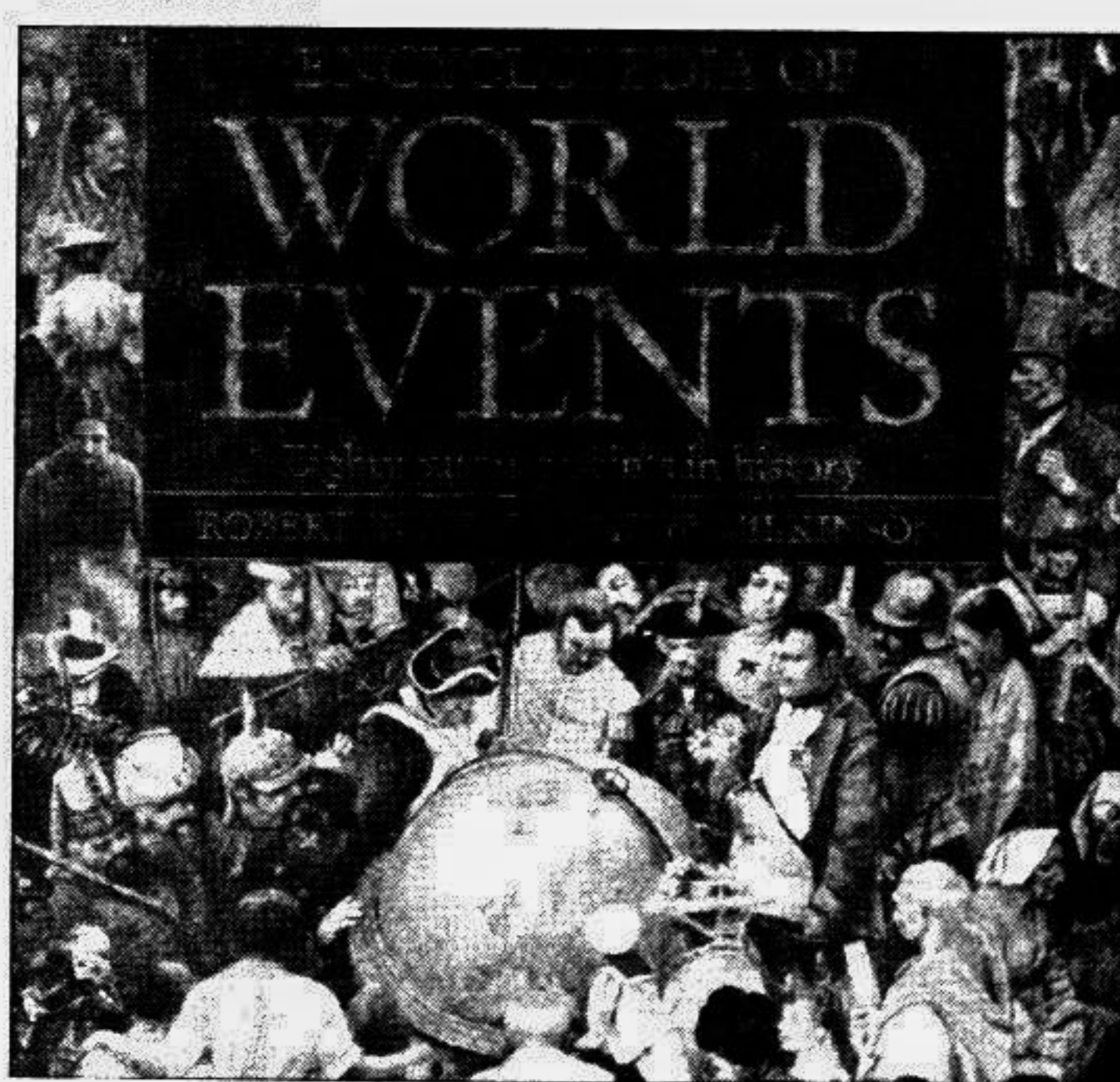

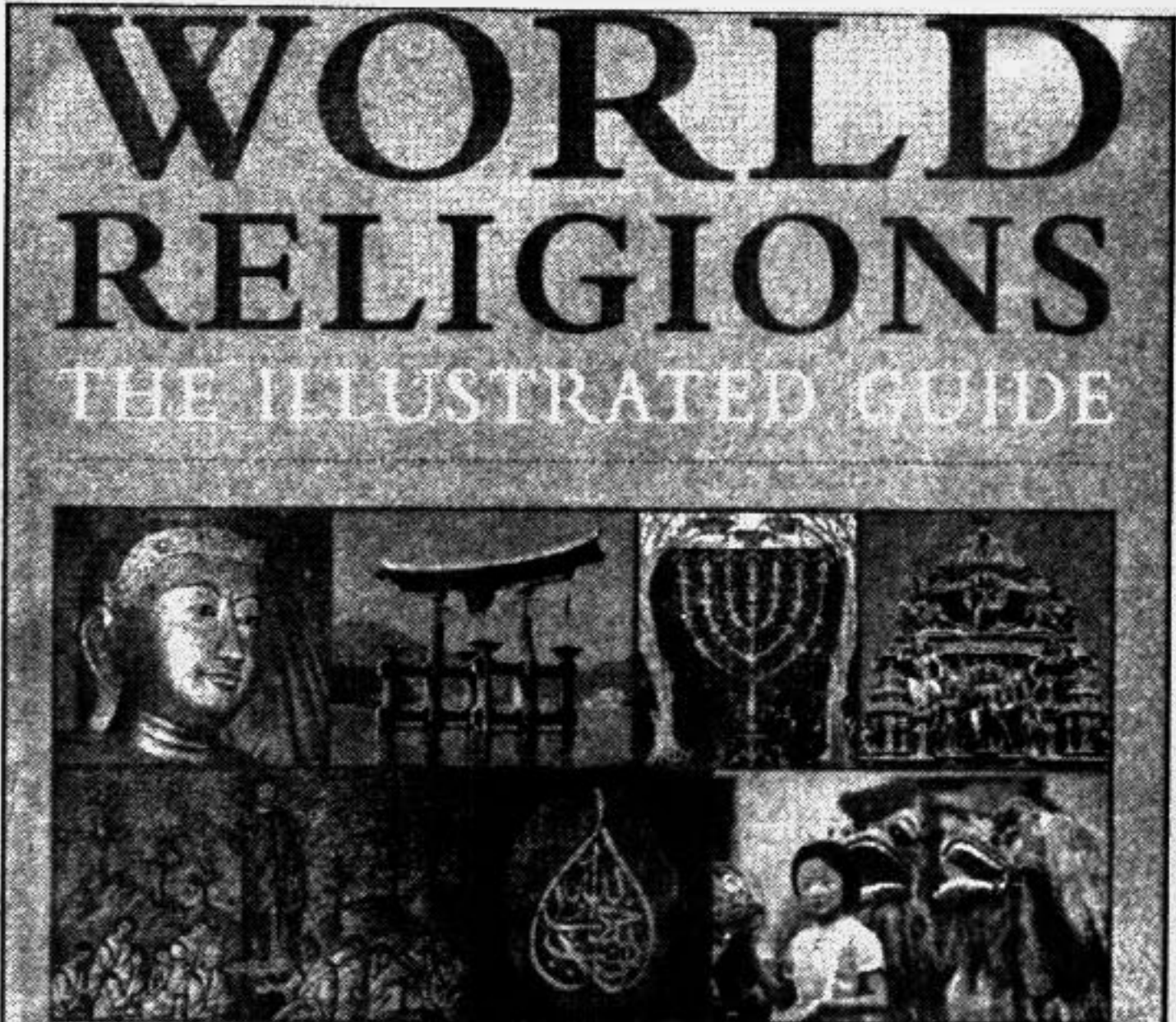
