In *A Poet Apart*, Clinton B Seely examines the life of Jibanananda Das and explores this Bengali poet's artistic development and the literary world in which he wrote. Born and raised in Barisal, a small town on the northern border of Bengal's famed Sundarban jungle, Das went off to Calcutta, the literary as well as political center of the Bengali world, first to attend college at Calcutta University and then to teach English literature at Calcutta's City College. The British Raj still presided over British India, but this power did not go unchallenged. Toward the end of the 1920s, owing to protests aimed at a visiting British Parliamentary Commission, Das — from no fault of his own — lost his Calcutta teaching post. It was during that decade that he began writing in earnest.
