Goethe and Tagore: Transition into Modernity

German scholar Martin Kampchen gives a talk on the two great renaissance minds of the West and the East

To celebrate Johann Wolfgang von Goethe's 250th birthday anniversary Dr Martin Kampchen gave a talk on the life and works of Goethe at the Goethe Institut yesterday. Dr Kampchen said, "Since we are here in Bangladesh, I thought of linking the talk with that on Rabindranath Tagore, a poet who is equal to Goethe. Both are universal geniuses. The exhibition which begins today goes under the heading 'Do We Still Have Universal Geniuses?' After Goethe, Tagore combined all facets of knowledge within one mind and became creative in numerous fields. I try to compare the universality of the talents that these two great men have. I try to give a list of all the arts like literature and natural sciences like geography, physics and chemistry which were in a nascent stage at that time but in which Goethe excelled. There was not too much of differences of natural sciences at that time. Goethe progressed in these sciences according to his own experiments and observations of nature.

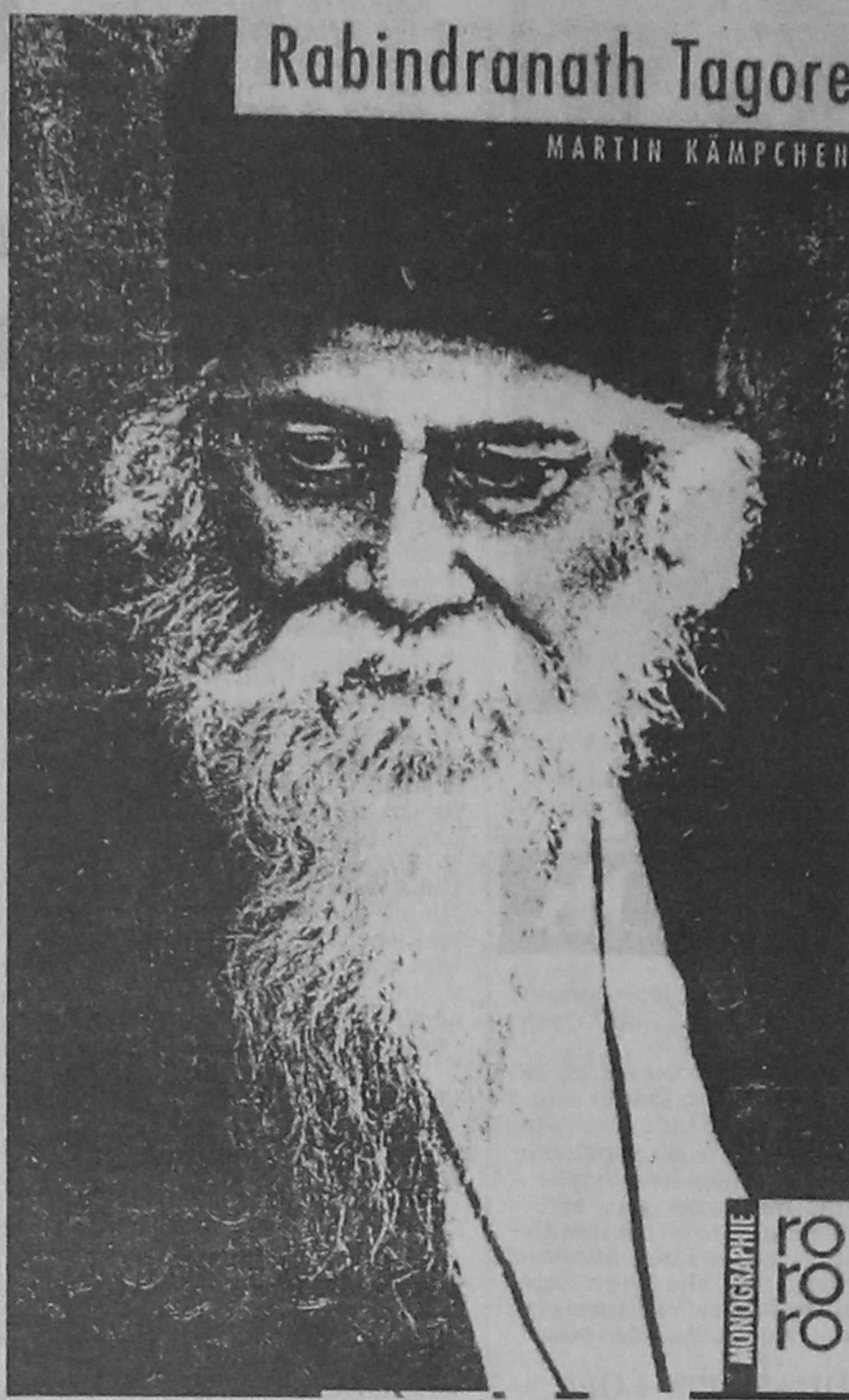
Dr Kampchen talked about the writings of Goethe, plays and scientific treatise. Goethe like Tagore was 'Augenmensch' (deriving aesthetic pleasure mainly through the eyes), said Dr Kampchen. "We have the play 'Dak Ghar' or 'Post Office' where the young boy Amal wants to see everything. Goethe tried to break away from the ornamental, archaic and florid poetry that went before him to achieve a realistic presentation of words. The realism that Goethe achieved is what we call the

classical form today. In the same way Tagore came to a clear and lucid style of prose which was basically realistic form of prose. Though a romantic at heart, Tagore tried to break away from overwrought symbolism. Goethe and Tagore were born in an old world order and tried to from a transition to modernity. Modernity for them was basically the presentation of realism," Dr Kampchen added.

Goethe (1749-1832) is acclaimed as the national poet of the German people. Similarly, Nobel Laureate Tagore (1861-1941) is viewed as the poet of the Bengalis - perhaps the poet of the subcontinent. But their eminence is not the only thing that allows for comparison. They both stand at the transition from tradition to modernity.

Dr Martin Kampchen did his studies in Germany, USA, Paris and Vienna. He obtained his Ph.D in German Literature from Vienna and his second Ph.D in Comparative Religion from Visva Bharati, Santiniketan. Besides his works like "A Documentation on Rabindranath", "German Biography of Tagore" and "Rabindranath in Germany", he has translated from Bengali into German selections of Tagore's poems and aphorisms.

Dr Kampchen's talk was accompanied by a film, "The Light, the dark and the colours" which sets out to illustrate Goethe's interest in natural sciences and an exhibition of 40 plates called "Goethe - a universal genius."

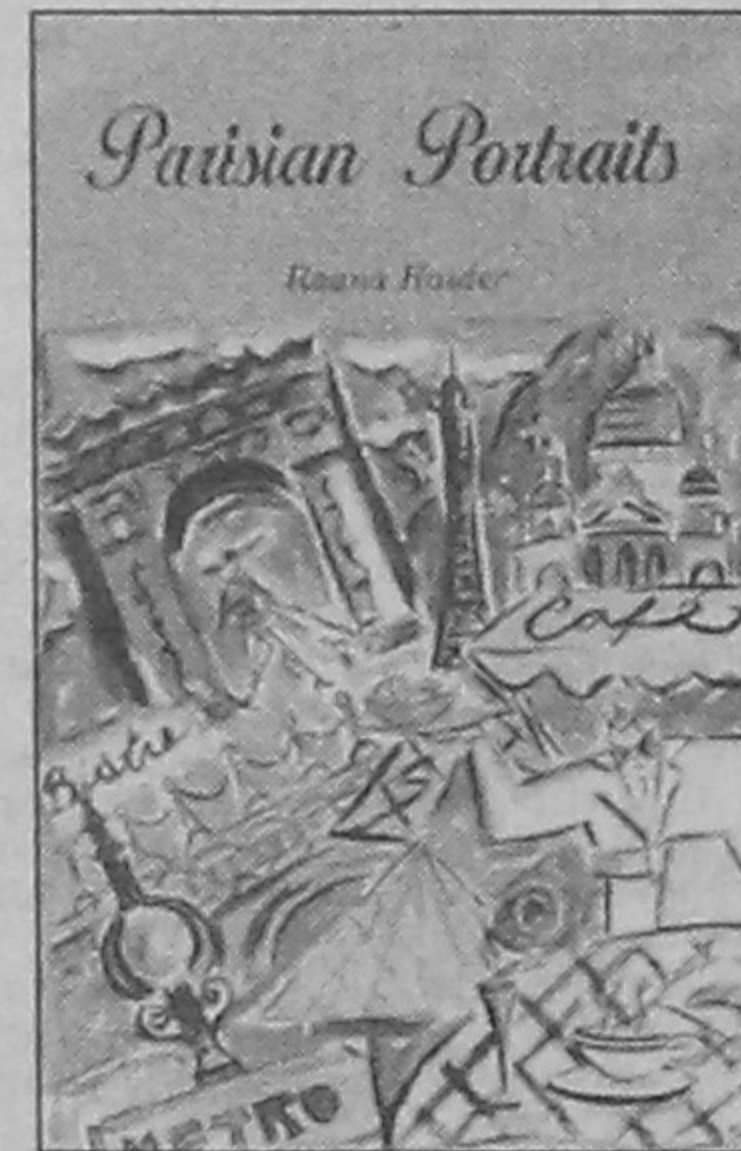
A Launching Ceremony of Raana Haider's Books

'Chitra Nadir Parey' Gets Good Response in India

RITWIKGHATAK'S "Titash Ekti Nadir Naam", shot in Bangladesh featuring Bangladeshi artists, has overwhelmed critics and lay viewers at the ongoing 31st International Film Festival of India. Bangladesh director Tanvir Mokammel's second feature film "Chitra Nadir Parey" screened at the festival twice, has also evoked 'good response' from viewers.

Ghatak's film predictably had been a big draw because it is not as often screened as his other works in India. The subject of the film - the lives of Malo fishermen along the bank of Titash - has attracted the film buffs in a big way.

The photography of the film by Bangladeshi cameraman Baby Islam and performances by actors and actresses of Bangladesh, including Kabari

Sarwar, in it have also come in for high praise.

"The visual appeal of the film is startling", says a review in "Indian express" newspaper. "Shot to a great extent using a low-level camera ever frame touches upon the damp soil of the river bank, the river and the sky in its vast expanse while each character plays out his or her life in front," it comments.

Tanvir's "Chitra Nadir Parey" was shown first at the festival's main venue Siri Fort Auditorium and then at a regular cinema hall in South Delhi as an entry in the Cinema of the World section.

Tanvir told "Daily Star" after the screening that he is "very happy" with the audience response to his film. Just before the screening at Siri Fort auditorium, the director spoke briefly on parallel cinema in

Bangladesh and about his own film.

He said organisers of festivals in southern Indian state of Kerala, Singapore and Australia met him soon after the screening of "Chitra Nadir Parey" and wanted it for showing there in March, April and June respectively.

Efforts are also on to screen the film for a week at a stretch at the prestigious "nandan" film complex in Calcutta, Tanvir said. The director said he was particularly enthused by the response his film received at the London International Festival in November last.

Tanvir said his next project is to make a film based on Syed Waliullah's classic novel "Lal Shaluu". He is ready with its script and the cast and is trying to arrange money for the work to start.
