

Students submit memo to DU VC

The students of the Dhaka University yesterday submitted a memorandum to the Vice Chancellor of the university demanding trial and exemplary punishment of the culprits involved in assaulting a young lady during the New Year's celebration at TSC.

The students under the banner of 'Students of Dhaka University Against Sexual Harassment' also demanded expulsion of the DU students involved in the incident.

They urged the DU authorities to formulate a code of conduct. They also threatened to launch a greater movement on the campus if their demands are not met.

Soft loan facilities for dairy farming in rural areas

Families in rural areas will be provided with soft loan facilities for dairy farming so that the dependence on milk import is removed from the country within the shortest possible time, reports BSS.

Rural families can take the opportunity to change their fates by taking credits and start dairy farming for milk production within their courtyards.

Fisheries and Livestock Minister ASM Abdur Rab told the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday.

He was making a statement on a private members' resolution on 'dairy farming being raised by Bharati Nandi Sarker of Panchagarh-Thakurgaon-Dinajpur.'

Rab said that the government would encourage all types of private investment and entrepreneurship in the country.

'Entrepreneurs in dairy farming will be encouraged specially as Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has already desired to see each unit of the rural family self-reliant on their own outputs,' he said.

Abdul Latif Mirza, Wazuddin Khan, Abdul Latif Biswas, Panchanan Biswas, Haji Mohammad Selim, Shahjahan Khan, Kazi Sirajul Islam and Kazi Sekander Ali moved their amendments on the resolution. The amendments were rejected by voice vote. Nandi withdrew her resolution following a request of Minister Abdur Rab.

President at Asiatic Society meeting 'Group championing' eclipses free play of mind in intellectual arena

President Shahabuddin Ahmed urged the country's scholars yesterday to retain their ideal insularity and 'free-play of mind' against 'group championing' for the sake of knowledge and civilisation, reports BSS.

Speaking at the biennial general meeting of the Asiatic Society of Bangladesh, he said despite defiance of 'material conditions' by some dedicated scholars, the domination of the group championing of ideas were causing a 'colossal loss in the world of knowledge.'

'What is despairing is the loss of the individual in the ever burgeoning and all devouring growth of group championing some real or imagined ideas venerated as rituals,' the president said.

He added: 'The group has become so powerful that the individual has failed to retain his ideal insularity and his essential free-play of the mind.'

President of the Society Prof Harunur Rashid chaired the function which was attended by leading academics, researchers, scientists and its members and fellows including chief of the former caretaker government justice Habibur Rahman.

President Shahabuddin said knowledge in any society has an 'essential insular character' and therefore, scholars were small group of 'self-exiled' people in their own domain of free-play of their mind.

Societies that care for knowledge have always supported such dedicated individuals and that has made possible the advancement of human civilisation. In return societies have benefited from the technology which came out of the painstaking research of the seekers of knowledge,' he said.

Sir William Jones, a British, founded the Society in 1784 in Calcutta as a learned body for research on man and nature of the continent.

In his speech, Prof Rashid said over the years the Society attached great importance on intellectual freedom and suggested development of independent research institutes free from government control for better performance and efficiency.

Echoing the President's concern, Prof Rashid said numerous research work done on both sides of the political divide were examples how scholars permit their intellect to be 'conditioned' by certain pre-conceived ideas and goals.

Currently, the Asiatic Society is working on an ambitious project to publish the much talked 'Banglapedia,' an encyclopaedia in Bengali.

Rehabilitation of evicted slum dwellers demanded

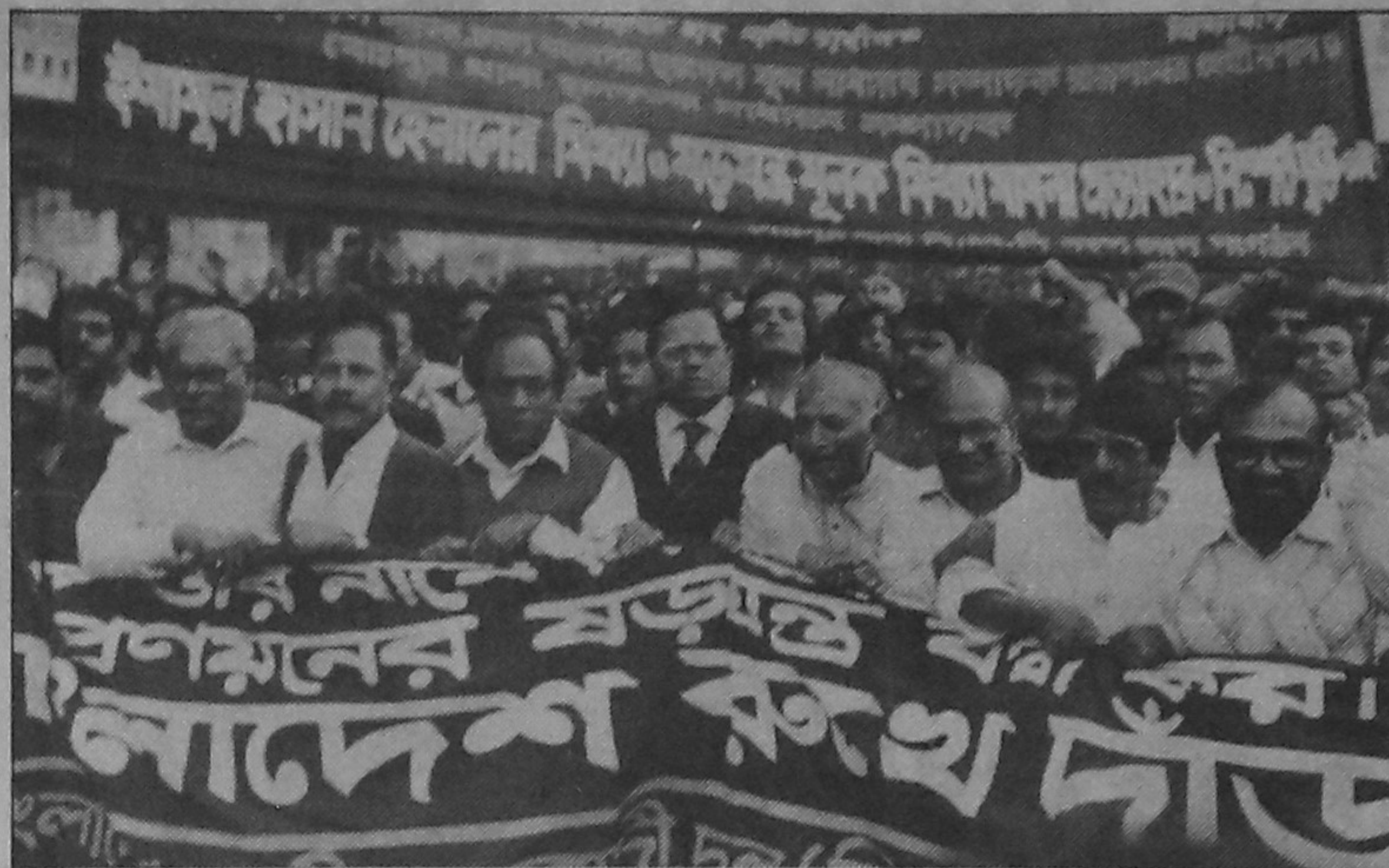

Seminar on 'Role of the opposition'

Call to protect parliamentary democracy

Political Adviser to the Prime Minister Dr S A Malek urged all, especially the intellectuals, yesterday to come forward to protect parliamentary democracy in the country, reports BSS.

'Parliamentary democracy is now at stake after the leader of the opposition shut down her door to talks to resolve political stalemate,' he said while addressing a discussion on 'Role of the Opposition in Parliamentary Democracy'.

He said: 'It is very unfortunate that the opposition leader has categorically rejected Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's offer to resolve the political standoff through dialogue, leaving no option for the government to explore.'

Dr Malek said there had been the possibility of enshrining parliamentary democracy in the country when Awami League led by Sheikh Hasina assumed office after winning people's mandate in free and fair general elections on June 12, 1996.

'But a certain quarter became active to foil parliamentary democracy as soon as Sheikh Hasina took office,' he said, adding, 'Begum Zia threatened to oust the present government just 90 days after it assumed power.'

Dr Malek called upon the intellectuals not to hesitate to protect democracy at a time when opposition political parties are mapping out a sinister blueprint to destroy it.

The discussion was also addressed by Chairman of Public Administration Reform Commission (PARC) A T M Shamsul Huq, General Secretary of Sangsadia Ganotantra Parishad Dr Harun-ur-Rashid, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Dr A K Azad Chowdhury, Pro-Vice Chancellor Mohammad Shahadat Ali, Dr Shamsul Huda Harun, Prof Ali Asgar, Prof Imamul Huq, Prof Mejbaidun Ahmed, Chairman of Bangladesh MuktiJoddha Central Command Council Principal Abad Chowdhury, and President of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalist (BFUJ) Abul Kalam Azad.

Justice K M Sobhan presided over the function. He said: 'The Opposition is the alternative government in a parliamentary democracy. If the government fails to run the state, the opposition takes power as an alternative government in the parliamentary system of government.'

He said the opposition was not following the parliamentary norms and practices. 'It is not clear to many of us on which grounds the opposition staged walkout within five minutes on the first day's sitting of parliament,' he added.

Criticising opposition leader Begum Khaleda Zia for her declaration that hartal will be used to create a deadlock, Justice Sobhan said the people will pay eventually for such actions.

He also questioned the logic of the anti-government movement of the opposition.

Dr Shamsul Huda Harun said, 'No government would be able to run the country, if the opposition does not play its due role in a parliamentary democracy.'

Ex-AI official calls on PM

Former secretary general of Amnesty International Ian Martin called on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her Sangsad Bhaban office yesterday, reports UNB.

Martin said that he was happy to note that Bangladesh is doing everything for the promotion of peace. He particularly expressed his satisfaction over the commendable role of Bangladesh in the UN Peace Keeping Missions.

'We hope Bangladesh will continue its commendable role in the UN peace keeping force,' he added.

The Prime Minister thanked him and said that Bangladesh is totally committed to peace. 'We have established democracy and restored peace in the country,' she said adding that a peaceful atmosphere should prevail in this region for development.

Referring to the Ashrayan project of the government, the Prime Minister said that our armed forces along with the civilians are working to build shelters for the homeless and institutions for the progress of the poor.

She said that through the Ashrayan project the government is rehabilitating the homeless of the country and also providing them with micro-credit, education and income generating vocational training.

She listed other government's efforts including the old age allowance, allowances for widows and women abandoned by their husbands and formation of an Employment Bank.
