# Asian bankers vow vigilance amid economic recovery

Caution against reliance on US, Europe as engines of growth

KUALA LUMPUR, Jan 27: Asian central bankers today took heart from the region's economic recovery but cautioned against relying on the United States and Europe as engines of growth and vowed to keep close watch on capital flows, reports Reuters.

Governors from the 11member South East Asian Central Banks (SEACEN) organisation, meeting in Malaysia's capital, called for closer cooperation among the region's central banks to ensure capital flows did not damage their resurgent

They also lamented that their call for reform of the global financial system had not borne fruit and appeared to have been brushed aside by Group of Seven industrialised

SEACEN comprises the central banks or monetary authorities of Indonesia. Malaysia.

Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, the which was growing on the back Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Taipei and

Observers from Cambodia, Fiji, Papua New Guinea and Tonga attended SEACEN's annual meeting, and Banco de Mexico governor Guillermo Ortiz appeared as a guest speaker.

#### US, Europe cause for concern

Malaysian Finance Minister Daim Zainuddin kicked off the meeting by saying the trend of rising interest rates and tighter liquidity in the United States and Europe would hit Asia.

"While global growth may continue to be supportive, the current trend of rising interest rates and tightening liquidity conditions in the US and Europe will certainly have implications on capital flows to Asia," Daim said.

Daim said the US economy,

of productivity gains and output growth in the computer industry, might not be able to sustain rapid growth.

"In addition, fears of an overvalued US stock market are compounded by global deflationary pressures which are already affecting the profitability of American corporations. Hence, the concern that a major correction may occur," he said.

Malaysia. which imposed capital controls in September 1998 to stem the outflow of foreign exchange during the Asian crisis, said countries should be allowed to adopt unorthodox exchange control measures and not be punished for their ac-

27: Flush with record 1999 profits and loaded with cash, General Motors and Ford are forging ahead with plans to restructure the supply chain and harness the power of e-commerce, a move likely to have far-reaching effects for the rest of the in-

dustry, reports AFP. "Right now, I think all the companies are being cautious in presenting exactly what kind of financial returns they are going to get" for 2000, he said. "But clearly ... they know they have to be (active in e-commerce). even though they don't know the exact business model that's going to emerge," said economist David Andrea with CSM Worldwide of Farmington Hills, Michigan.

Ford and GM - the "Big Two" of US automakers - have embraced e-commerce. And analysts say their moves were likely to pay off as a e-commerce will continue to surge in both business-to-business and consumer transactions.

DaimlerChrysler, which has yet to jump on the e-commerce bandwagon, will likely to follow their lead.

And activities by Ford and GM - the "Big Two" - will help shape the futures of smaller auto companies and suppliers alike, according to analysts. As David Cole, who heads automotive studies at the University of Michigan puts it: "It's a Ford-GM game ... They are defining the industry."

Both companies reported unparalleled earnings for 1999, following the strongest US vehicle sales year in history.

Despite deep discounts and special incentive programs, GM last week reported record yearend earnings of 5.6 billion dollars on revenues of 176.6 billion dollars during the year. On Wednesday, Ford announced 1999 earnings of 7.2 billion dollars on revenues of 163 billion dollars.

After 1971, almost the total need of tobacco used to be imported from Pakistan. The company worked closely with farmers and by 1975 had attained self-sufficiency for which the President's Award on Agriculture was conferred upon British American Tobacco Bangladesh (the then BTC).

The company then concen-trated on developing quality to-bacco for export and started exporting tobacco in 1983. In spite of the difficult global tobacco market, exports have been made to UK, USA, Belgium, New Zealand, Hungary, Ger-many, Sri Lanka and Nepal.

In 1996, BATB earned foreign exchange worth over US\$854,000 from export. Thereafter, expansion of new markets was initiated and the export volume went up signifi-cantly to 987 MT in 1997 and 1130 MT in 1998, earning foreign exchange worth US\$2.2 million and US\$2.23 million respectively. The total exports earnings of the company from 1983 to 1999 stands at

US\$14.30 million. The company is the largest revenue generator in the private sector and contributed Tk 980 crores to the government ex-chequer in 1998-99 fiscal year in the form of VAT & supple-
