cally known as barhat.



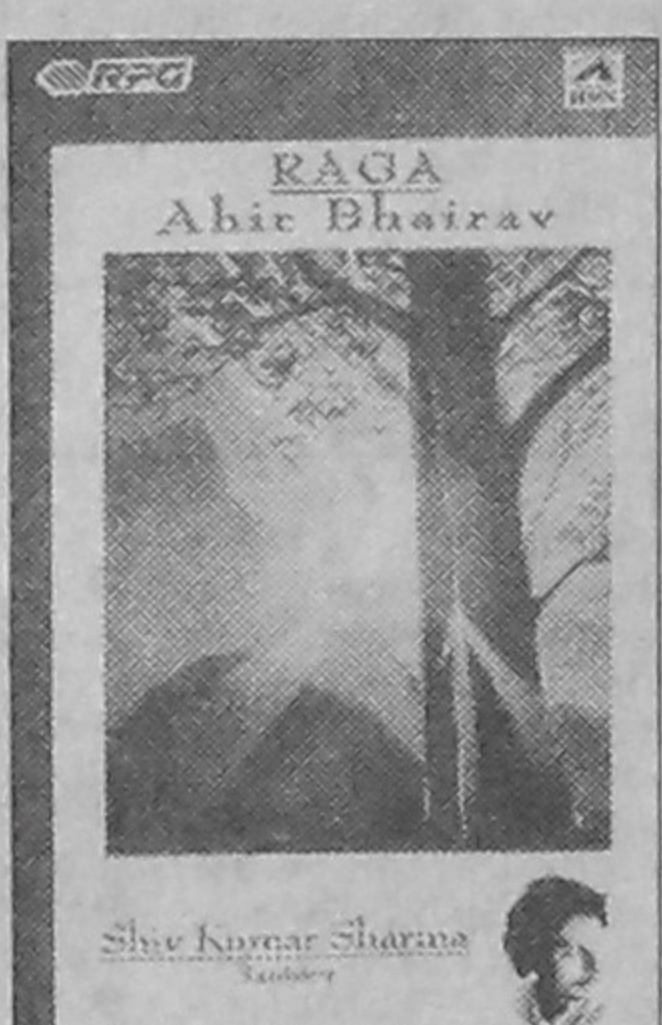
