#### Bangladeshi scientist discovers protein

vital for life form

By Staff Correspondent A Bangladeshi scientist named Dr Magsudul Alam, an Associate Professor of Microbiology in the University of Hawaii. USA has discovered a new class of proteins which may help trace, when and where life began on Earth and if it exists elsewhere in the universe.

Dr Alam in collaboration with his colleague Dr Randy Larsen, an Associate Professor of Chemistry, discovered the proteins.

The researchers, both instructors in the College of Natural Science, identified a new class of myoglobin-like proteins in extremophiles or Archaea, the most positive form of

Their discovery has created a sensation in science world. reported US media. American news media has published his paper and telecast researchers interviews.

The researchers termed the protein as a gold mine for evolutionary research and said that it is a brand new class of heme-proteins that's never been

Dr Alam is the lead author of a paper on their findings that appears in the British journal Nature.




