Prevailing politics has deepened deadlock at CU

CHITTAGONG, Feb 17: Vice-Chancellor of the Chittagong University Prof Abdul Mannan today said that the prevailing deadlock of the university has deepened as opposition led politics across the country has integrated with the student politics.

"Now all instructions come from leader of the opposition Khaleeda Zia" Prof Mannan said while talking to BSS along with two other university correspondents of the national dailies at his city residence.

The vice-chancellor sought the cooperation of all concerned to maintain congenial academic atmosphere saying university, the highest seat of learning, should be considered by all as an institution instead of centre for politics.

The university authority is now too busy with the police instead of discharging academic

activities, Mannan said.

Giving details about the prevailing situation of the university, Prof Mannan said, it is said that a section of teachers are involving themselves in student's movement.

Mannan said that it is unfortunate that BNP-Jamaat backed teachers are not extending cooperation to the liaison committee which was constituted on the basis of their recommendations to resolve the problems of the university.

They have further complicated the problems by resigning from the liaison committee now and then. Prof Mannan said adding that the syndicate, according to demand, raised by the teachers and students, has recommended a judicial inquiry to probe all killings on the campus since 1986.

The deadlock was created at

the university when Islami Chhatra Shibir has enforced a siege programme on the campus for an indefinite period since January 16 last demanding arrest of the killers of their activists.

The vice-chancellor emphatically said that there is no alternative to discussions involving all concerned for immediate solution to the present stalemate at the university.

Two shot in city

Two young men were shot in separate incidents in the city yesterday.

The victims were identified as Abu Sayeed, 45, son of Khalilur Rahman, and Moslem Ahmed, 22, son of Khorshed Ahmed.

According to hospital sources, a gang of four extortionists fired on Sayeed at a construction site in Dhokakhal at about 4 pm when he refused to pay toll. Sayeed was shot in his right leg.

In the other incident, Moslem was hit by a stray bullet during a gunfight between two rival groups in Gopbagh.

He was rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital with bullet wound in his stomach.

Meanwhile, Motijheel police recovered the body of a newborn from a dustbin in South Jahangpur yesterday.

Police rushed to the scene and recovered the body at about 10.45 am after receiving a tip.

Combing operation: 813 held, arms, explosives recovered

A total of 813 persons were arrested and 15 illegal weapons, 50 rounds of bullet and 11 explosives were seized during the 301st day of the countrywide combing operation by police, Bangladesh Rifles and Ansar force, reports BSS.

The combined forces arrested 378 persons on different charges from across the country including four metropolitan areas and seized the arms, ammunition and explosives. They also arrested 432 wanted accused and three-listed terrorists during the operation.

A total of 72 persons including two warrantees were arrested from Dhaka Metropolitan area and seized one illegal weapon and two illegal explosives and three bullets while 17 persons including one warrantee from Chittagong Metropolitan area.

7 persons including four warrantees were arrested and

one illegal arms recovered from Khulna Metropolitan area while five persons from Rajshahi Metropolitan area.

163 persons including 106 wanted accused were arrested from Dhaka Range and seized six illegal weapons and 38 bullets while 210 persons including 119 wanted persons were arrested and five illegal weapons, seven bullets and nine explosives recovered from Chittagong Range.

103 persons including 66 warrantees were arrested from Rajshahi Range and seized one illegal arms while 146 persons including 76 warrantees and three terrorists were arrested and one illegal arms and two bullets recovered from Khulna Range. A total of 37 persons including 20 warrantees arrested from Barisal Range while 50 persons including 38 warrantees from Sylhet Range.

Indian HC for projection of Ekushey background

The Indian High Commissioner to Bangladesh, Dev Mukharjee, yesterday said the global recognition of February 21 as the "International Mother Language Day" is the recognition of cultural identities of the people all over the world.

Talking to BSS at his Gulshan residence, he recalled with respect the sacrifices made by the people of Bangladesh in the historic Language Movement in 1952. He said recognition of such an event, perhaps, also is a recognition of the importance of language and culture that play in the life of people all over the world.

Perhaps no other country other than Bangladesh has given blood to establish the right to speak in mother language, Mukharjee pointed out and suggested that it is the responsibility of the people of Bangladesh to project the history of the language movement.

Because he said, as the Ekushey February would be observed as the International Mother Language Day from this year, certainly questions will arise in the minds of people as to why February 21 has been chosen for observing as the International Mother Language Day.

He said people, at large, should be provided with all information about the significance and importance of the day. By informing the people about the Ekushey February sacrifices, Bangladesh could project its cultural and linguistic history.

Mukharjee said in this connection the UNESCO can also play a meaningful role in disseminating information and history of the Language Movement of the people of Bangladesh.

Replied to a question, he said it is of course a great recognition to all those who had struggled and laid their lives for establishing the right to speak in the mother tongue since February 21, 1952. The Language Movement, in fact, sharpened the Bengali nationalism, which culminated in the independence of Bangladesh in 1971, he said.

CMM issues summons on 2 for criminal breach of trust

The court of Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (CMM), Dhaka issued summons on two persons including a director of Valentine Developers and a manager of Pubali Bank for criminal breach of trust and misappropriation of about Tk 18 lakh.

A press release of Monowara Hospital yesterday said that the summons were issued on the basis a criminal case filed by the one of the directors of the hospital.

The complainant said that the accused availed of air ambulance service from Bangladesh to Singapore presenting security of two cheques worth about Tk 17.43,500, which was endorsed by the manager of Pubali Bank.

The cheques were later dishonoured by the bank and returned unpaid, the release added.

BCL welcomes PSA

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), student wing of ruling party, brought out a procession on the Dhaka University campus welcoming the Public Safety Act, during hartal yesterday.

Following the procession, the BCL held a rally at the Aparajeo Bangla at noon.

Addressing the rally, BCL leaders termed the act as 'timely' and said, "the enactment of the law will ensure safety of life and properties."

They also protested the role of opposition alliance and blamed for exploding bombs during the first day of 36-hour long hartal on Wednesday.

"Opposition alliance is creating panic among the people and hampering the normal activities in the name of hartal", they said.

The BCL leaders also urged the BNP-led opposition alliance

to be refrain from calling hartal for the sake of country's economic development.

Presided over by Bahadur Bepari, the rally was addressed, among others by Aiy Kar Khokan, Balaram Podder, Likat Sikder, Ashrafur Azim Rubon, Saifuddin Nasir, Sajjad Hossain and A K M Azim.

Meanwhile, the classes and other academic activities were hampered on the last day of 36-hour countrywide hartal.

According to the sources, some residential students of the university were seen studying in the Central Library.

The administrative building of the university remained open but the official activities were partially operated, sources said.

Neither picket nor any activists of opposition alliance were seen during hartal around the campus yesterday, sources said.

Woman robbed of medical papers

A woman employee of Accountant General of Bangladesh (AGB) was robbed of her money and important medical papers in front of Al-Helal police box in broad daylight yesterday, reports BSS.

Police said Raushan Ara Begum was stopped by two snatchers in front of the police box at about 1-30 pm when she was returning to her AGB colony residence from work.

The muggers, riding on a motor cycle, snatched the handbag of the woman, who is carrying, "I had some important medical papers in the bag," she said.

The hijackers were able to flee from the scene despite the presence of some police constables at the box, who did not go to help her.

No case was registered with Motijheel police till this evening.
