
Feb 23 at 10:00 PM on Star Movies Starring Sandra Bullockand Chris O'Donnell


CONTEMPORARY ART IN BANGLADESH

This is the second in the Arts the Islamic World's current series of I' ame volumes in a hardbound format, and is devoted to "Contemporary . . ri in Bangladesh." It was planned as a homage to one of Asia's most distinguished art schools, established more than 50 years ago as a Government Institute of Art - now the Institute of Fine Arts, University of Dhaka. Its Golden Jubilee celebrations, postponed last year because of catastrophic floods which virtually brought everything to a standstill for several months, were held earlier this year. These provide an opportunity for critically evaluating the modern art movement which it catalysed, and to look back on a marvellous track record that, when the Art Institute started its tenuous journey in 1948, should have seemed almost like an impossible dream.






Planning and Management of WATER RESOURCES

The management and development of water resources, has been a major area of public intervention in Bangladesh. The Bangladesh Water Development Board started designing and implementing various types of flood control and drainage projects since the fifties. Over the years, some 500 projects have been implemented. About a quarter of this program have been designed and executed through Early Implementation Projects (EIP). They were small, low-cost, and quick yielding projects. This book analyzes the performances of these projects and the impacts of the EIP on the institutional development of the BWDB.




Postcolonial Developments
