7000 people die in road accidents a year

Seminar on safe community told

CHITTAGONG, Feb 23: Road accidents kill around 7000 people every year in the country and also destroy property worth about Tk 2000 crore, reports BSS.

At least 2,320 fatalities and 4,510 injuries were reported from 4010 road traffic crashes in 1999 while in the first nine months of the last year, the death toll was 2,500. This was revealed by speakers at a seminar as part of 'The 9th International Conference on Safe Community' held in the auditorium of Chittagong Medical College today.

The speakers said that in addition to road traffic accidents, violence, homicide, suicide, drowning, landslides, snake bites, natural disasters, poisoning and other types of injuries are increasing alarmingly in the country.

Principal of the Chittagong Medical College Prof Shubhagata Chowdhury presided over the seminar. Among others, Pro-Vice-Chancellor of the University of Science and Technology Dr L A Quaderi, former director general of the health service Prof Nurun Nabi, Prof Arabinda Barua, Dr Moa Saundstom of Sweden, president of the travelling sub-committee Prof Probat Chandra Barua, Dr Majeda Abdur Rashid and journalist Samir Barua took part in the seminar.

Neuro medicine expert Prof M A Faiz and resident editor of the Daily Prothom Alo Abul Momen presented papers on 'Safe Community: Some Thoughts' and 'Child Safety: Some General and Regional Aspects' in the seminar, conducted by Dr Jahid Hossain Sharif.

Two more papers on environment and air pollution and sexually transmitted diseases were presented by Dr Jobair Bin Alam and Prof Shariful Islam at the seminar which has been designed with the basic objective of 'setting child safety priority within a safe community framework'.

The participants said injuries are causing great concern to the community in Bangladesh and about two million people die from injuries each year in developing countries.

Quoting a recent study in the rural area of the country, speakers said it has been reported that 93 per cent of the deaths of women aged between 15 and 24 years were caused by injuries.

45 Rohingya refugees return home

COX'S BAZAR, Feb 23: Forty-five more Rohingya refugees of six families voluntarily returned to their homes in Myanmar today from a refugee camp here, reports UNB.

Officials of UNHCR and Rohingya Repatriation Commissioner's Office saw them off on the bank of the river Naaf in Teknaf frontier this morning. Official sources said some 2,31,018 Myanmar Rohingya refugees belonging to 46,245 families have so far returned to their homeland voluntarily.

In last nine years, 31,636 Rohingya babies were born and 7,616 refugees died in the refugee camps.




