Maya yesterday urged the local
entrepreneurs to take the ad-

Minar after placing of wreaths.

A reception will be accorded

try at the Muktamancha in the
evening which will be followed
by a cultural function on the
same day.

The tree plantation pro-
gramme and sports events will
be held at the university central
playground on March 9.

The 'Rag Festival 2000' will
be rounded up by a concert on
March 10 at 'Muktamancha'.


