The ball passed harmlessly to wicketkeeper Adam Gilchrist but it sent Quested marching down the wicket to pass on the warning to captain Shane Warne, who took over the reins when Steve and Mark Waugh were rested from the four-day match.

Lee (1-57) was clearly frustrated during a luckless day as Northern Districts finished the opening day at 295-9.

The day was ideal for the Australians, who have spent just three full days in the field in their last 10 Tests. Glenn McGrath (3-40) was among those who benefited after a series of one-day matches.






