About 60 per cent work has, so far, been completed and the rest is expected to be completed by the end of June, 2000.

With the completion of work at least 15,000 students of both sexes will enjoy better educational facilities in these educational institutions, official sources added.

Another report says: One hundred and fifty nine development projects are being executed in seven northern districts at a cost of Taka one hundred fifty nine crore during the current fiscal year.

The districts are Rangpur, Gaibandha, Nilphamari, Lalmonirhat, Dinajpur, Panchagarh and Joypurhat.

The projects included water supply, extension of Pally Biddut lines, river erosion protective scheme, construction of buildings of medical colleges, municipalities and union parishads, fire stations, school buildings, roads, bridges, culverts and iron removal plants.

A high official told that about 60 per cent work of the development projects has, so far, been completed and rest 40 per cent work is expected to be completed by the end of this

In Sunamganj, Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) implemented 42 projects of reconstruction of bridges, culverts, roads last

The construction cost of Taka 1.60 crore was provided from ADB assisted maintenance programmes.

LGED official sources said, flood in 1998 damaged some bridges, culverts and roads in different places. Due to the damage, the roads became unsuitable for transportation. After implementing the reconstruction programme about five lakh people are getting better communication facilities.

In Jessore, LGED, Jessore has been implementing a project of reconstruction of 19 rural roads.

The approximate cost of the reconstruction is Taka one crore eighty lakh. According to Executive Engineer of LGED. Jessore, the present government is relentlessly working for the advancement of industry and agriculture. LGED has taken up the project to materialize this goal. Reconstruction programme for 19 roads, out of the total devastated rural roads has been taken up primarily on priority basis.
