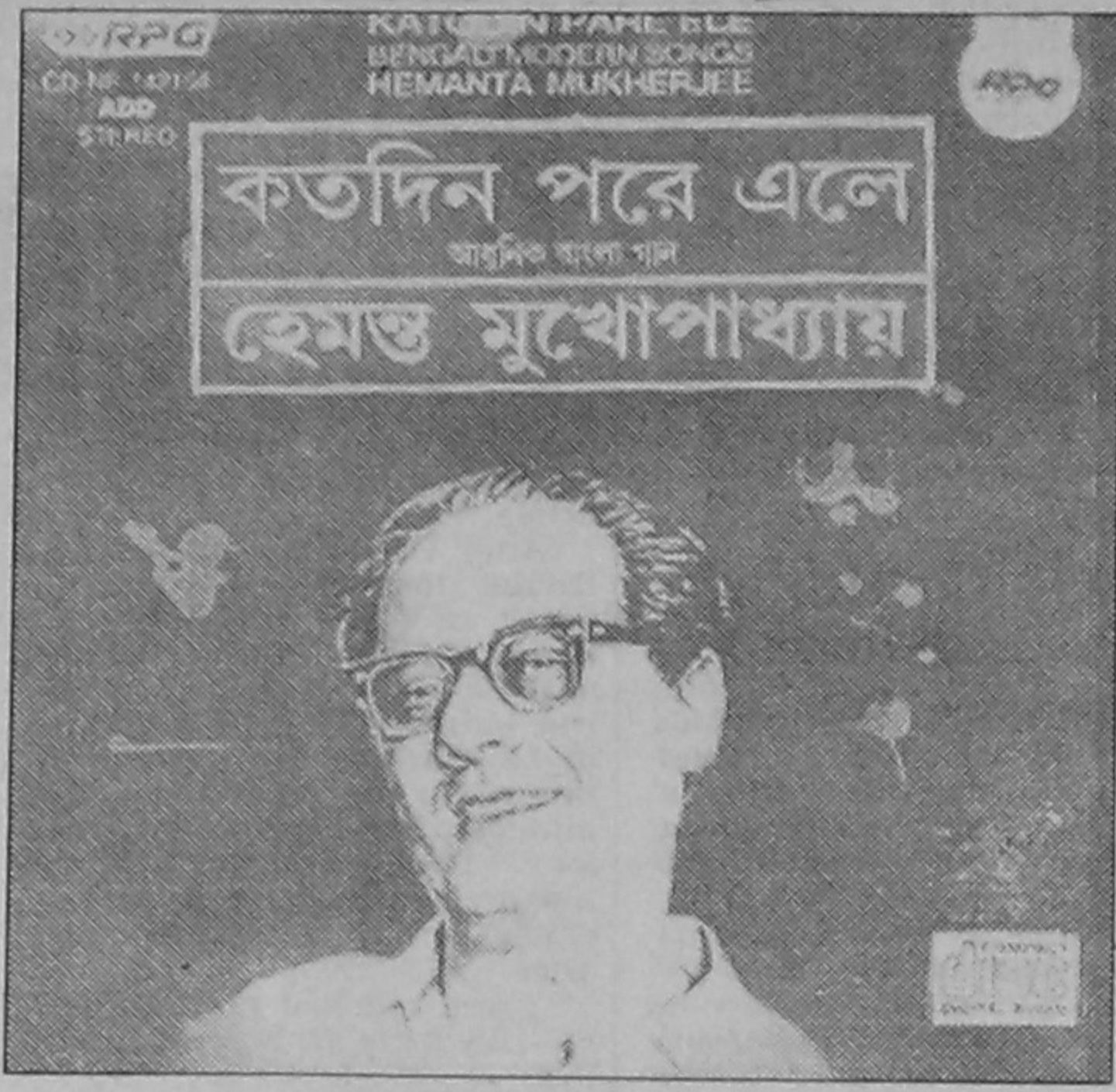

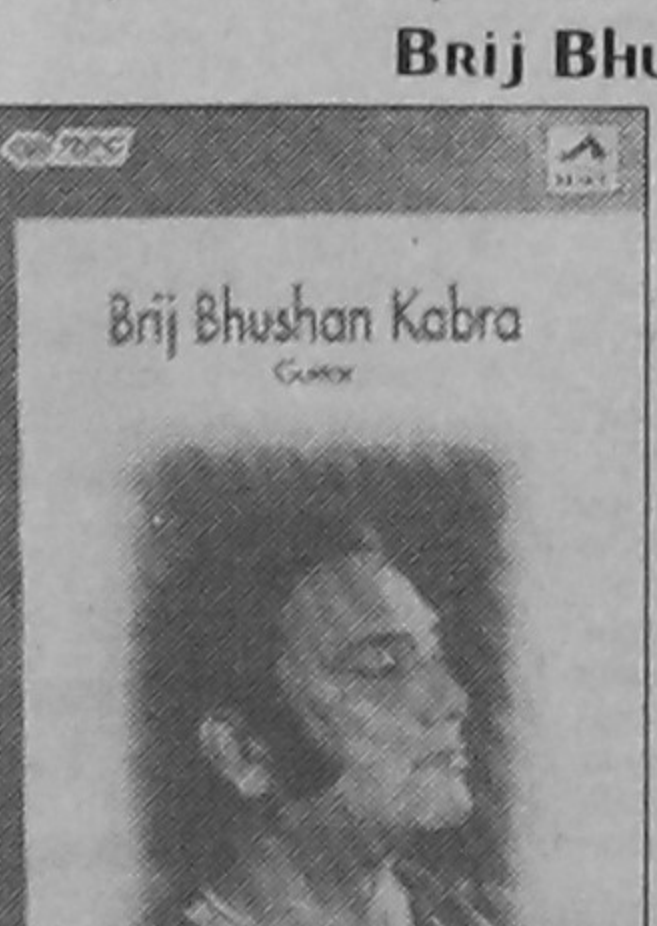
DRUMS OF INDIA

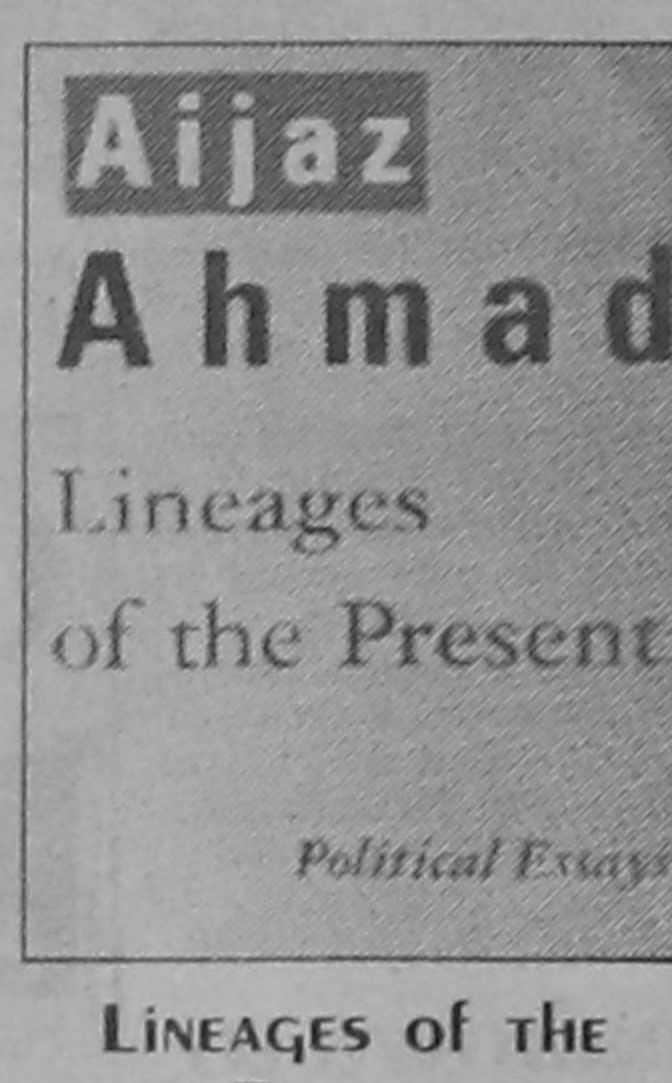
SEVEN WONDERS OF THE COSMOS

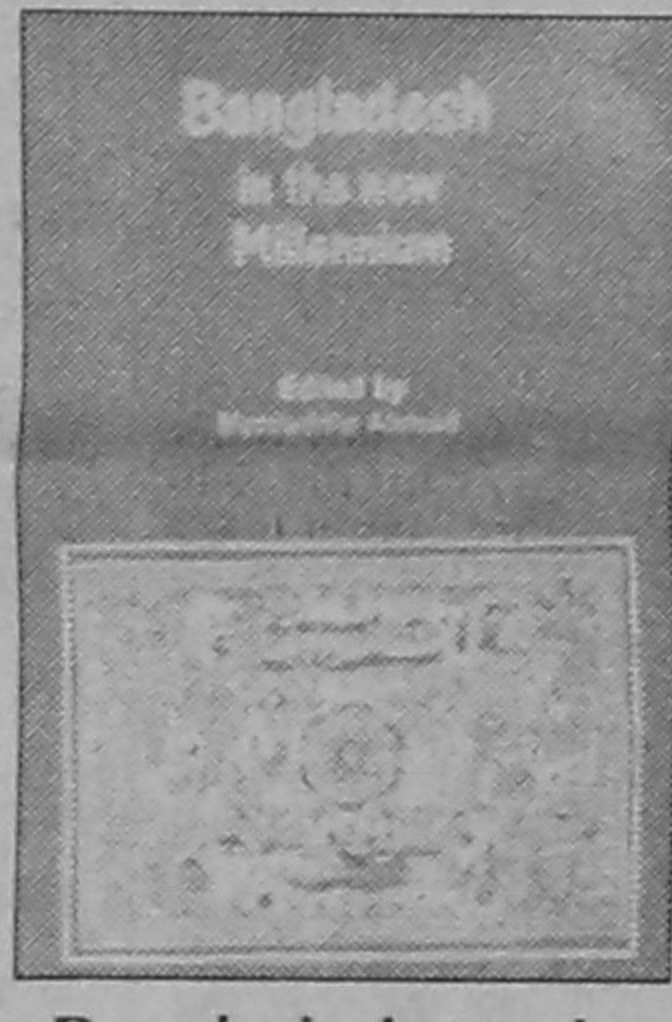
