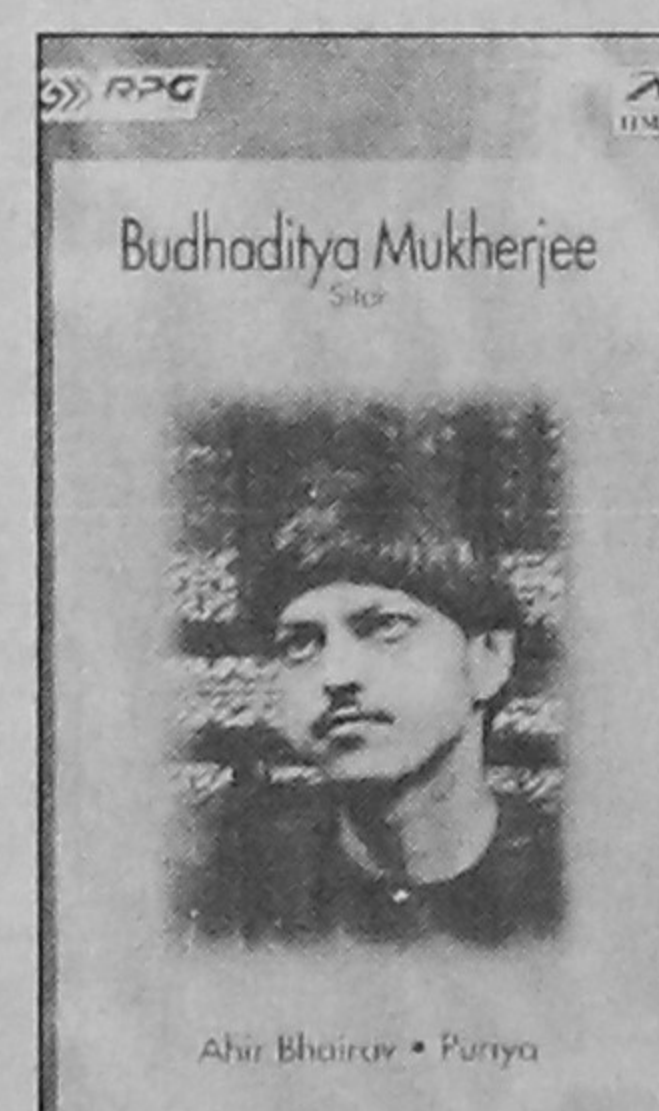
GWALIOR GHARANA

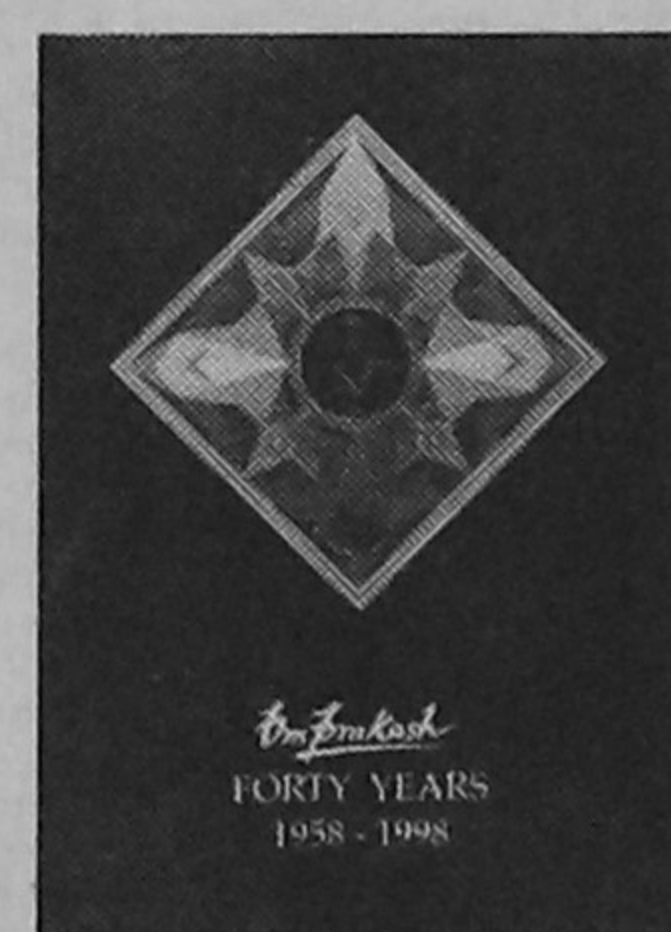


BENGALI POLITICS

Most of the documents included in this series are the fortnightly reports of the Governor of Bengal to the Viceroy and Governor-General of India and deal with a variety of subjects, issues and events that were perceived by the Governor as of supreme importance needing the personal attention of the Governor-General. In summarizing and underscoring many significant developments in the province, much of which were not otherwise reported or recorded, these fortnightly reports present, in addition to a myriad of facts and interpretations, a close look on the working of British colonialism and imperialism in Bengal.

It reviews some of the major initiatives in health, population and nutrition which are emerging and considers how primary health care services can be strengthened in Bangladesh so that "health for all" can become a reality in Bangladesh sooner rather than later. The Sarangi is the most priceless instrumental symbol of contemporary khayal, and is the mother of the ethos and gamaka-techniques of the most popular khayal styles of the modern era. The significance of the instrument arises primarily out of its traditional role as the melodic accompaniment to vocal khayal.

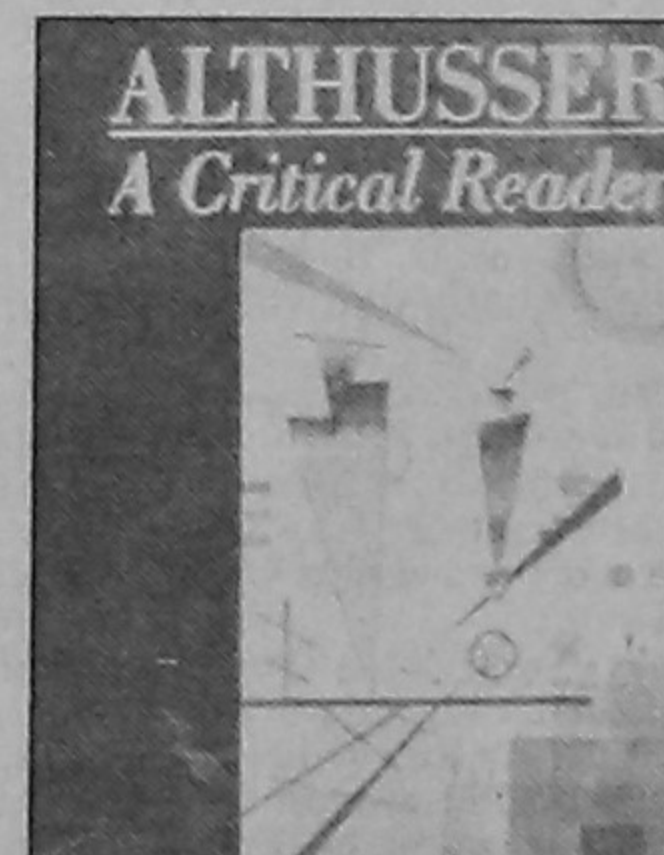
