Johnson sets Pretoria afire



PRETORIA, Mar 25: Double Olympic champion Michael Johnson smashed the world best time in the rarely-contested 300 metres at a Grand Prix II meeting on Friday, reports Reuters.

The American clocked 30.85 seconds to beat the previous mark of 31.48, set by compatriot Danny Everett and Cuban Roberto Hernandez in Spain a decade ago, by well over half a second.

Johnson said he had been confident of going under 31 seconds for the event, which he last contested six years ago.

He broke the world mark running virtually on his own, with the second-placed finisher, Hungary's Zsuzsanna Dombi, nearly two seconds behind in 32.73.

"I tried to use kind of a 200 strategy but hold back a little bit in the second 50 metres," said Johnson.

"I got out good for the first 50, just backed off a little for the second 50 and then from 200 metres to go I just went pretty much all out.

"This is not... an Olympic distance but it's still a world record, the best that anyone's ever done so I'm proud of it," said Johnson, who holds the world records for the 200 and 400 metres.

"The race is not run very much so I think it was a race that I ran a lot I could probably break it by even more. I always felt that the record was hard to break but I didn't think the time was as good as it could possibly be.

"My main objective this year is to stay healthy and I think everything else will fall into place," said Johnson, who was accompanied to the track at the Pilditch stadium by his physiotherapist.

"These races just really confirm that I am in great shape right now and ready for this year," added Johnson who

hopes to successfully defend his 200 and 400 metres titles at the Sydney Olympics.

"When I'm healthy and I'm in good shape I'm as confident as I can be and I don't think there's anyone out there who can beat me."

Johnson ran the fourth-fastest 200 metres all time at Pilditch last Saturday. He will race the 400 metres in Cape town next Friday.

World javelin record holder Jan Zelezny of the Czech Republic kept his promise to the meeting organisers to throw over 90 metres with a best attempt of 90.59.

In the hammer throw, Finland's Olli-Pekka Karjalainen threw the best distance in the world this year, with 79.63 metres on his third attempt.

Australian Patrick Dwyer clocked a career best 44.73 seconds in the men's 400 metres, with two South Africans, Hendrick Mokganyetsi (44.85) and Marcus la Grange (44.99), also establishing personal bests.

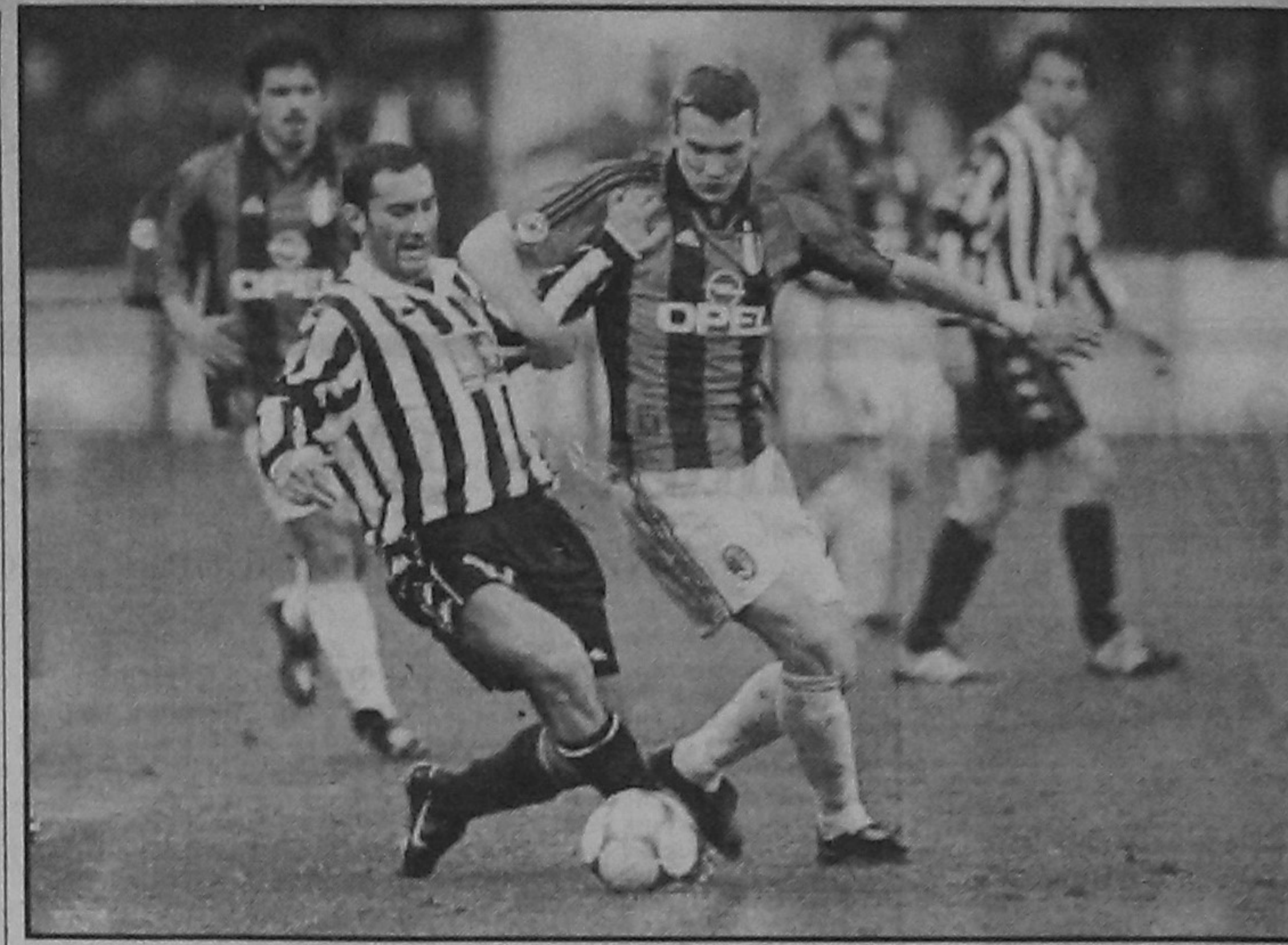

Shevchenko sinks Juve



MILAN, Mar 25: Two goals from Ukrainian Andriy Shevchenko gave AC Milan a 2-0 win over Juventus in Italy's

Serie A on Friday, ending the league leaders' 22-game unbeaten run and giving hope to title challengers Lazio, reports Reuters.

Juventus remain nine points clear but their lead could be cut to six points if second-placed Lazio beat AS Roma in today's derby.

Lazio then face Juventus in Turin on April 2, the next in a series of tough games for Carlo Ancelotti's side and one that will go a long way to determining the outcome of the Serie A title.

This clash between the two clubs who have kept the title between them for the past eight seasons was not a classic but Milan showed they still have the strength of character to secure a Champions League berth for next season.

Heavy rain before the match made for a greasy surface and neither side were able to take control in a scrappy opening period.

Juve could have taken the lead in the 21st minute when Filippo Inzaghi intercepted an underhit back-pass from Paolo Maldini and rounded Milan goalkeeper Christian Abbiati but shot wide.

On the stroke of half-time Milan went ahead when Thomas Helveg whipped in a cross from the right and Shevchenko rose above Edwin Van der Sar to head home.

Milan almost added a second goal straight after the break but Jose Mari's header flashed just wide of the post.

Juventus went close at the other end when Zinedine Zidane set up Inzaghi but the Italian striker saw his shot fly wide.

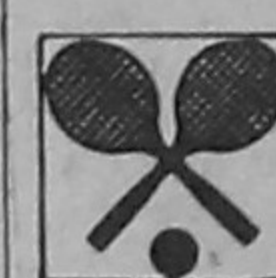
Juve piled on the pressure and added Yugoslav Darko Kovacevic to their attack as they desperately sought an equaliser but the nearest they came was a long-range effort from Edgar Davids which whistled over the bar.

With six minutes remaining Shevchenko was judged to have

been brought down inside the area by Alessandro Birindelli and despite protests from Juve players, the Ukrainian kept his cool to slot home his 21st goal for the season, the spot.

Shevchenko, the leading scorer in the league in his debut season, was keen to play down his night of glory.

Rafter starts in style



MIAMI, Mar 25: Patrick Rafter continued to improve after returning from shoulder surgery scoring a solid 6-4, 6-2 victory over 6-foot-5 (1.96 metres) Max Mirnyi of Belarus on Friday, reports Reuters.

In other matches, Martina Hingis was not dazed by her opponent's glittering gold outfit. Anna Kournikova was unfazed by questions about her personal life and Monica Seles, back from injury, also advanced with a second-round win.

Rafter, a two-time US Open champion, is playing in his fourth tournament since dropping off the tour at last year's US Open. For the first time since the injury, his trademark volleys seemed crisp (26 of 34 net points won) and his first serve a weapon (27 of 30 first-serve points won).

"I'm very happy with the way I stroked the ball today," said Rafter, who reached the semifinals here in 1993.

Rafter, seeded 15th, will play France's Sebastien Grosjean in the third round with top-seeded Andre Agassi lurking in a potential fourth-round matchup.

In the final Stadium court match of the evening, crowd favourite Kournikova, the

glamorous Russian teen who lives a few miles away from here, fought off feisty American Jenny Hopkins 6-2, 6-4.

Once top-seeded Hingis got past flamboyant Canadian Maureen Drake's gold-shimmering outfit with leopard stripes, she cruised to a 6-1, 6-4 victory.

Fourth seed Nathalie Tauziat needed to save six match points to defeat American Tara Snyder 6-3, 2-6, 7-6 (8-6), in two hours, 41 minutes. The 83rd-ranked Snyder held five match points with Tauziat serving at 4-5 in the third set.

Sixth-seeded Conchita Martinez went three sets before Australian teen Jelena Dokic fell 6-4, 3-6, 6-3.

Seles, seeded seventh and coming back from a stress fracture of the right foot, eliminated fellow American Lilia Osterloh 6-4, 6-1 to set up a third-round match against Lisa Raymond.

In other first-round men's matches, Davis Cup stalwart Jim Courier, a former world number one at four-time Grand Slam titlist, battled for two hours, 11 minutes to overcome Argentine qualifier David Nalbandian 6-3, 3-6, 7-5.

Britain's Greg Rusedski drew a tough first opening-round opponent in Ukraine's Andriy Medvedev but prevailed 6-4, 7-5.
