

Meet The Blue Rider Group

Ride on CD-ROM and embark on a tour of the 1911 exhibition by the famous German expressionist painters

EVERY age has its own way to look into the past. The present age which is dubbed as computer age naturally would like to negotiate with its past with the computer. And it did. The result is quite stunning: You can now flip through the diaries of the master painters such as Wassily Kandinsky, Paul Klee, Alex Jawlensky and many others who were related with the famous artists group, Blue Rider, who helped shape the face of modern art. You can also do your queries about their lives, about their idiosyncracies, and their theories of art. Until April 9 you can actually engage yourself in an interactive user participation with the aid of CD-ROM featuring touch-screen displays at Goethe Institut at Dhanmandi. The exhibition has been jointly designed by Goethe-Institut, Lenbachhaus museum, München, Siemens Nixdorf and Prestel Verlag.


The treasure-trove that will unfold before you contains a) Information on the founding of the group and its position with the regard to the other art movements of the day in Europe b) Detail biographies of all the artists of the group c) Folk art, primitivism from where the group member drew their inspiration and were influenced and d) An in-depth tour of the Lenbachhaus museum where the group held its first exhibition and also the museum's present collection.

So, you have the key to the past and now take time to relive in a past that contributed significantly in our aesthetics present.

In 1896 Kandinsky, one of the founder father of the group, moved to Munich to study art. After travelling extensively and a one year stay in Paris, Kandinsky settled in the Germany and there began an extremely creative phase and also there started an intensive exchange

of ideas with other artists living in the vicinity such as Franz Marc, Alex Jawlensky and Marianne von Werefkin. In the summer of 1911, Kandinsky and Marc decided to publish an almanac which was later called Der Blaue Reiter or The Blue Rider.

This was a publication exclusively reserved for artists — be they painters, musicians, or writers on art — in which they could freely express their views about a new artistic movement on an international level. The composers Arnold Schonberg and Thomas von Hartmann



were invited to contribute. Kandinsky submitted his now famous article 'Über die Formfrage' ('On the Question of Form') and 'Der gelbe Klang' ('Yellow Sound'), and Franz Marc contributed his essay 'Geistige Güter' ('Spiritual Goods'), introducing the artists' programme, and 'Die Wilden Deutschlands' ('The Wild Ones in Germany'). The special fascination of the almanac, which, in its synthesis of text and picture, may be regarded as the most significant programmatic publication on art in the 20th century, lies in its revolutionary way of looking at the different forms of art from various eras. Works by European artists such as El Greco and Cezanne



arrangement of the exhibition is documented in a series of photographs taken by Gabriele Munter. Fourteen artists were involved, including Kandinsky, Marc, Muncher, Macke, Albert Bloch, David and Vladimir Burlin, Heinrich Campendonk and Robert Delaunay, as well as Arnold Schonberg and, posthumously so honoured, Henri Rousseau. The variety of styles represented in the exhibition was justified by saying that all exhibits were products of "inner necessity".

Kandinsky described the exhibition as a juxtaposition of painters of great abstraction (besides himself, Marc and Delaunay) and painters of great realism.

The second exhibition of

are juxtaposed with African sculpture and so-called "primitive" art, children's paintings



and "Hinterglasmalerei" (naïve paintings on glass panels). The aim was to prove that "artistic essence," as Kandinsky put it, is not a question of form but of inner artistic content.

The cover of the almanac was decorated with woodcut by Kandinsky showing a stylised image of St. George. This "Blue Rider" was adopted as the symbol of a revivalist movement that sought to transcend the oil world petrified in materialism and to usher in a new era dominated by "the grand spiritual."

The "First exhibition of the Editorial Staff of The Blue Rider" was presented in 1911. The

exhibition will remain open for visitors 12 noon to 8pm except Friday.

One mother spent \$5,000 on a dress recently. They'll stop at nothing."

"The judges are looking for a total package," says Pam Breedwell. "Hair, clothes, modelling, smile and personality have got to be just right." Veteran of the circuit since she was nine months old, stony-faced Brooke only comes alive on stage. She's won a car and over \$7,000 in prize money but is still wary of her main rival, five-year-old Asia Mansur, from Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Asia's mother can't afford a modelling teacher and scripps on Asia's clothes, but says: "Asia's got talent. Asia can sing, she can entertain, Asia can win. 'Boo, Asia's Dad, disagrees: 'A lot of people are getting rich on pageants and the kids who don't win get hurt.'"
