BCL protests Khaleda's remark

Leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), the student organisation of the ruling Awami League, protested the recent remarks of BNP chairperson Khaleda Zia on Bangabandhu murder case.



Rubel murder Two prosecution witnesses cross-examined

Two prosecution witnesses in the Rubel murder case were cross-examined in the Third Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judges' Court yesterday.

The court adjourned the proceedings of the case till today.

In their statements, the two witnesses — Dhiresh Chandra Sarker and Uzzal Ahmed — said they saw Rubel being tortured in BD custody as they were on remand.

Rubel was groaning. There were marks of torture on his body, they said. At one stage, he became senseless. Two hours later, some plainclothes men appeared there and took him to hospital, they said.

On the flowing day, they came to know that the young man (Rubel) died at hospital.

Shamim Reza Rubel, 24, a BBA student at Independent University, was picked up by BD police from near his residence at Shantinagar in the city on July 23, 1998 and tortured to death in custody.
