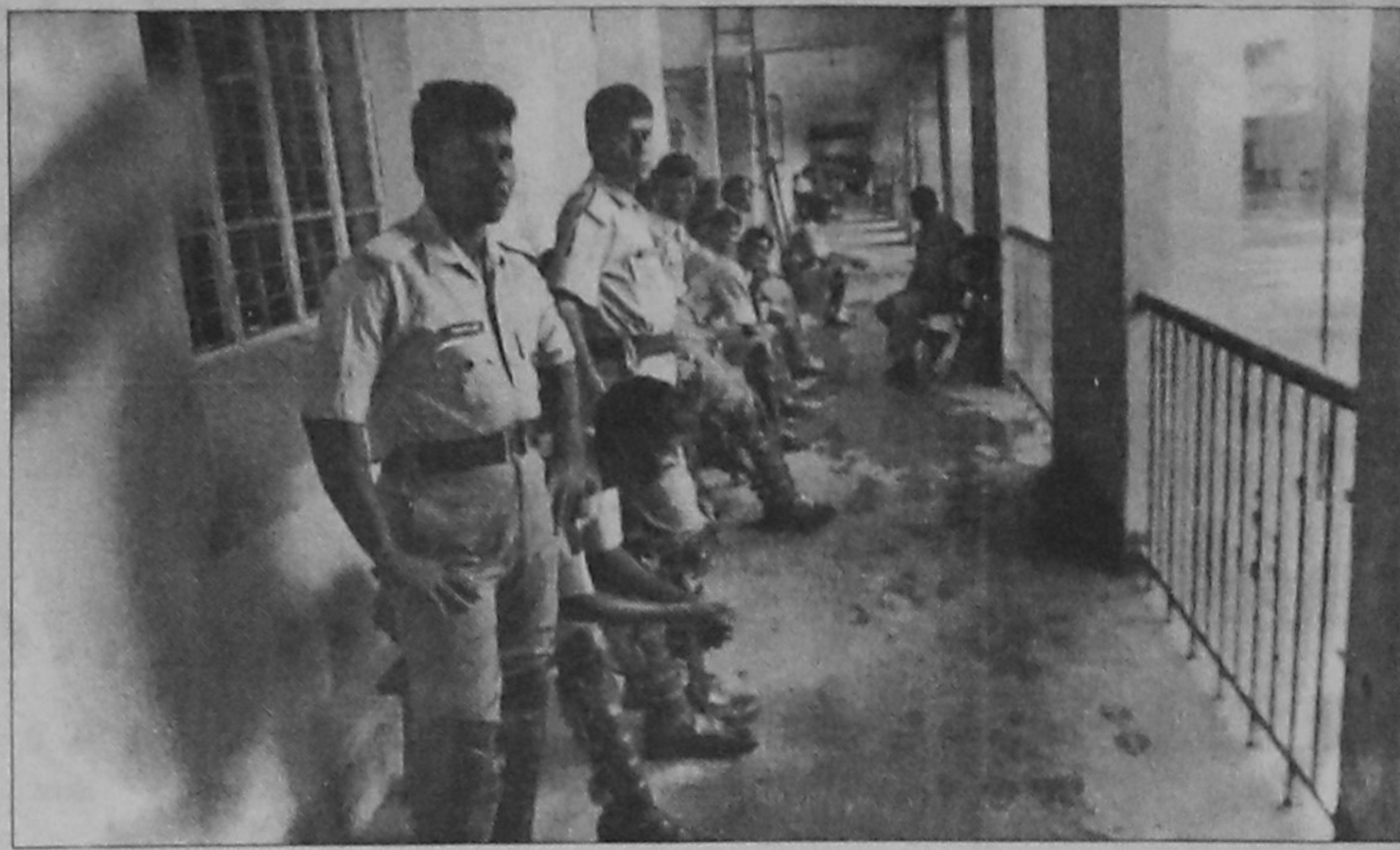

Rubel murder
Two prosecution
witnesses
cross-examined

Two prosecution witnesses in the Rubel murder case were cross-examined in the Third Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judges' Court yesterday.

The court adjourned the proceedings of the case till today. In their statements, the two witnesses - Dhires Chandra Sarker and Uzzal Ahmed - said they saw Rubel being tortured in BD custody as they were on remand.

Rubel was groaning. There were marks of torture on his body, they said. At one stage, he became senseless. Two hours later, some plainclothes men appeared there and took him to hospital, they said.

On the following day, they came to know that the young man (Rubel) died in hospital.

Shamim Reza Rubel, 24, a BBA student at Independent University, was picked up by DB police from near his residence at Shantinagar in the city on July 23, 1998 and tortured to death in custody.

AC Akram Hussain and Mukul Begum, accused in the case, were produced before the court yesterday.

6. Candidate must learn Japanese Language and he will have to study in Japanese Language.

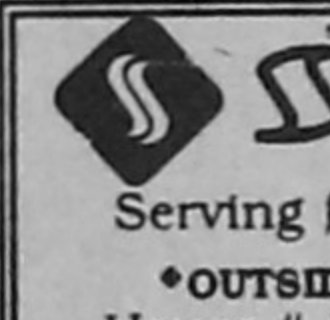
