

First community clinic opens today

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will inaugurate the first community clinic at Gamadanga village in Tungipara under Gopalganj district today.

Under the fifth five year health programme, about 13,500 community clinics will be set up across the country to provide 'one stop' service.

Each clinic will offer essential service package (ESP), including primary healthcare and limited curative care services, and address other basic needs of the population.

The concept of community clinic replaces existing door-to-door services by the family planning volunteer workers. People who are a maximum of half-an-hour away will be able to use healthcare services.

The services include safe motherhood, family planning, prevention and control of reproductive tract infection and HIV/AIDS, maternal nutrition, adolescent and neonatal care.

Under child healthcare, the clinic will offer services like prevention and management of diarrhoeal diseases, nutritional deficiency, acute respiratory infection and vaccination.

Under the communicable disease control programme, it will offer services like prevention and management of malaria, filaria, kala-azar, tuberculosis, leprosy, intestinal parasite attack and sexually transmittable diseases.

Each community clinic will have three rooms occupying about 450 square feet. One will be for health and family planning, second one for labour room and the third room will be used as waiting room.

A community group or

committee comprising paramedics will run the affairs of the clinic. Although there will be no provision for presence of doctors in the clinics but doctors will pay visit to some clinics, if needed.

According to health Minister Sheikh Fazul Karim Sellim, construction of about 6000 clinics are expected to be completed by June.

All this is taking place under the newly launched health programme known as Health and Population Sector Programme (HPSP).

He hoped that such visits would help widen the existing defence cooperation between the two air forces.

Raymond thanked the President for receiving him and described the existing defence cooperation between the two air forces as satisfactory.

Project taken up to rehabilitate sex workers in 4 dists

JESSORE, Apr 25: The government has taken up a 'Sex Workers Rehabilitation Project' in four districts of the country. The districts are — Dhaka, Jessore, Mymensingh and Rajbari, reports BSS.

Social Welfare Department (SWD) will implement the project with financial help from UNDP.

At the first stage, 4,435 sex workers will be rehabilitated. Coordinator of the Project, Shamsul Alam, informed BSS.

Necessary medicines, health education, sanitation facilities and vocational training will be provided to the rehabilitated sex workers.

In the second stage, they will be provided with employment according to their qualifications and ability, so that they can become self-reliant. SWD has appointed an NGO named 'ACLAN' to discharge responsibility on behalf of SWD.

The SWD has appointed four coordinators for the four districts. Every coordinator will form a committee consisting of public elected persons and government officials who will conduct a survey on the numbers and condition of the sex workers in their area.

According to official sources, at the initial stage, 2800 prostitutes from Dhaka, 300 prostitutes from Mymensingh, 1000 from Daulatdia of Rajbari, 335 from Marua-mandir and Jhali Patti of Jessore town will be rehabilitated under the project.

A reunion meeting of Bangladesh Krishak League (BKL) will be held at the Gt High School ground at Tungipara today on the occasion of the 28th founding anniversary of the league, reports BSS.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is expected to inaugurate the reunion.

Former and present leaders of the league will attend the function.

BKL president State Minister for Land Alhaj Rashed Mosharraf and General Secretary Harun-or-Rashid Howladar has urged all members to attend the meeting, said a press release.

Regional Director of C'wealth Youth calls on FM

Regional Director of Commonwealth Youth Programme Raka Rashid met with Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad at his office yesterday, reports UNB.

During the meeting, they discussed matters of mutual interests, particularly those of the Commonwealth Youth Programme.
