Under the fifth five year health programme, about 13,500 community clinics will be set up across the country to provide 'one stop' service.

Each clinic will offer essential service package (ESP), including primary healthcare and limited curative care services. and address other basic needs of the population.

The concept of community clinic replaces existing door-todoor services by the family planning volunteer workers. People who are a maximum of half-an-hour away will be able to use healthcare services.

The services include safe motherhood, family planning. prevention and control of reproductive tract infection and HIV/AIDS, maternal nutrition,

adolescent and neonatal care. Under child healthcare, the clinic will offer services like prevention and management of diarrhoeal diseases, nutritional deficiency, acute respiratory infection and vaccination.

Under the communicable disease control programme, it will offer services like prevention and management of malaria, filaria, kala-azar, tuberculosis, leprosy, intestinal parasite attack and sexually transmittable diseases.

Each community clinic will have three rooms occupying about 450 square feet. One will be for health and family planning, second one for labour room and the third room will be used as waiting room.
