4 arrested with arms in city

Police yesterday arrested four people, including three robbers from Motiheel and Jatrahari areas and recovered arms and ammunition from their possession, reports BSS.

BFUJ, DUJ joint meet today

Leaders of both the factions of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) will meet in a conference at 11 am today to discuss ways to expedite the reunification process of the two unions, reports BSS.

In a joint statement, leaders Amanullah Kabir, G M Yakub, Akhtar Ahmed Khan, M A Aziz, Altaf Mahmud, Abu Saleh and Abdul Jalil Bhuiyan urged the unit and deputy unit chiefs and the executive committee members of BFUJ and DUJ to attend the meeting to be held at the Jatiya Press Club.

The statement issued by the Sangbadik-Sramik-Karmachari Oikya Parishad also urged all journalists, employees and workers of the newspapers not to work on May Day and observe the day in a befitting manner.

The signatories also called for a four-hour work stoppage from 10 am on April 30 in all newspapers and news agencies to press home the nine-point demand of the journalists, employees and workers of the newspapers and news agencies.

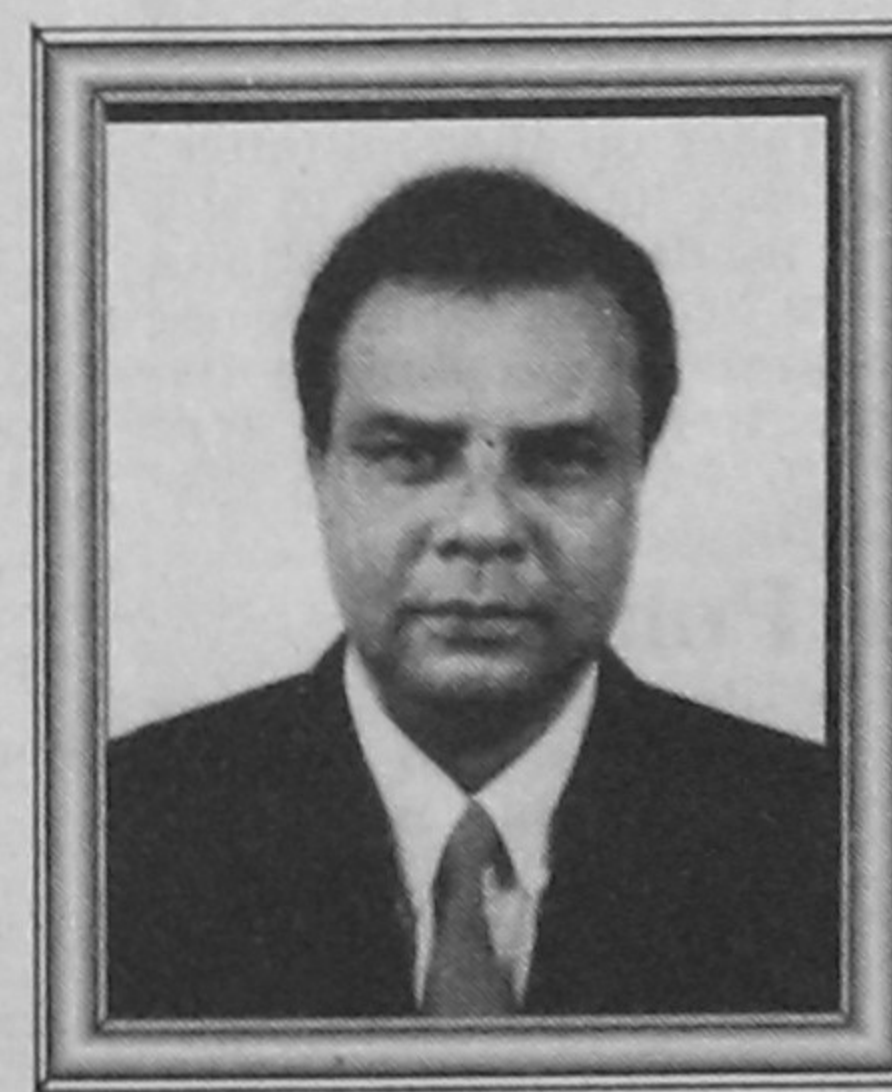
