

# Tagore's valuables lost from Shahjadpur Kuthibari

Shelaidaha wakes up from slumber

SIRAJGANJ, May 10: Rabindra Kuthibari at Shahjadpur here has taken a festive look during celebration of a three-day Rabindra Joyanti programme. Many stalls of various articles have been set up in a three-day fair arranged on the occasion. Stall owners from far and near places have thronged here. Many even came here from Dhaka, Narsingdi, Khulna, Kushtia and Bogra with their commodities. The place has become a centre of great reunion.

On the second day of the programme on Baishakh 26, "Talitir Math", a drama adapted from the original story of Rabindranath Tagore and directed by Papri and Laurence have been staged at Shahjadpur Rabindra Kuthibari.

Sirajganj Shilpakala Academy arranged the programme. Ullapara Upazila Sangkritik Jote also staged a drama and a musical programme with dance drama at Rabindra Kuthibari.

But regrettably Rabindra Kuthibari is now a neglected place and has become a centre of corrupt people.

It is learnt that Kazi Emdad was in-charge of the Kuthibari from 1989 to '97 and Sohrab Ali

palki (palanquin) but the authority concerned misappropriated the fund by repairing only with very inferior quality wood.

Meanwhile, the construction work for Rabindra Kuthibari at Shahjadpur has been completed at a cost of Tk 2 crore and 60 lakh. But before handing it over to the authorities concerned, frequent gambling, unsocial activities are going on. It is also alleged that many miscreants are bringing call girls here from outside.

The concerned employees who are engaged in selling tickets among the visitors, adopting unfair means. He is allegedly making money through bad practice.

As a result the government is depriving of a huge amount of revenue.

Now the small river the Jaygeer, which runs near the Kuthibari is being dried up and the local influential are grabbing the area which belong to Kuthibari. In this small river, Rabindranath Tagore used to take bath and engaged in fishing.

Beside this river, he composed the poetry Sonartari, Chitra, Chaitali and Kalpona, short stories Gopoguchho, Postmaster, Ramkanaiyer Nir-

Shelaidah, otherwise an obscure hamlet on the bank of the River Padma, woke up as Rajul Islam Minister of State for Energy and Power inaugurated the two-day national level Rabindra Joyanti programme.

### Livestock office earns profit

### Road dacoity committed

NAOGAON, May 10: Armed bandits committed dacoity in three trucks at Taltoli in Bihariganj on Naogaon-Joypurhat road after barricading the road on Monday night, reports UNB.

### 2 killed in road mishap

HABIGANJ, May 10: Two people were killed and 40 others injured when two buses collided head-on at Satchhari hilly area here on Dhaka-Sylhet highway on Tuesday, reports UNB.

Police said Chandra Mia, 55, of Madhabpur and Shaheen, 15, of Chunarughat died on the spot in the collision which took place between the Madhabpur-bound bus from Habiganj and the Sylhet-bound bus from Comilla at noon. Of the injured, eight were admitted to Chunarughat Health Complex and two to Habiganj Sadar Hospital.

### Another killed in bus mishap

MADARIPUR, May 10: A bus and a private car collided head-on near Mostofapur Bridge on Dhaka-Barisal highway killing a man and injuring four other people, reports UNB.

Police said the Shariatpur-bound private car and the Dhaka-bound bus of Chandra Paribahan crashed at about 11 am killing the private car driver Masud, 30, on the spot. Injured Poll, 25, Saimon, 65, Sajju, 35, and Azizul, 30, were admitted to Madaripur Sadar hospital. All of them are the passengers of the private car.
