## 36 sued under PSA in dists

A total of 36 persons were sued under Public Safety Act (PSA) recently in various districts.

**Our Sirajganj correspondent reports:** The first case was filed under Public Safety Act (PSA) in Sirajganj on Wednesday.

Special tribunal judge of Sirajganj issued a warrant of arrest against 10 businessmen in connection with the case.

Complainant Maqbul Hosain, owner of Alhaj Cold Storage of SS road in the town, alleged that owner of Sirajganj Cloth Society Iqbal Kabir Shamim along with his associates forcefully seized the cold storage and grabbed all assets at day light.

Judge Rafiqul Islam issued the warrant of arrest against Iqbal Kabir Shamim, Humayun Kabir, Ahsan Kabir, Shahidul Kabir, Liakat Ali, Rabi Selim, Rahman, Mohiuddin and Haq.

**Our Magura correspondent says:** The district and sessions judge court here on Wednesday sent district Judge Juba Dal convener and five other activists of Chhakra Dal and Juba Dal to jail *hazat* in a case under Public Safety Act (PSA) on charge of attack on former minister Majid-ul-Huq's residence.

Six accused of the case including Khan Hasan Imam (Sujan) and Khaleduzzaman (Nanna), respectively the district Juba Dal convener and district Chhakra Dal convener

and district Chhakra Dal organising secretary, surrendered to the court with a prayer for bail. The court rejected the bail prayer and sent them to jail.

Shafiqul Islam, a nephew of former minister filed a case under PSA with the Sadar thana, accusing district Juba Dal convener and six others for their involvement in the attack on the house.

Police, after investigation, submitted chargesheet against the accused persons.

**Our Feni correspondent reports:** A case was filed at Feni thana under PSA against five JCD leaders including district JCD secretary, vice-present on Sunday for creating a road barricade.

According to police sources, police filed a case at Feni Sadar thana under PSA against five JCD leaders including district secretary Kamrul Hassan (Masud), vice present, Mushefur Rahman (Repul), Kapiluddin Mamun, Nurullah Chowdhury and Sawkat Hossain (Sakil) for road barricade and created panic through bombs blast on Pangachia road in the town on May 6 evening.

Local people came to his rescue and caught hold of Abbas, but Rezaul managed to escape.

Accused Abbas was later handed over to Daulatpur police station. Police sources also said that the accused sent a letter demanding toll to Faruq and accordingly they came to Faruq to collect the toll. The accused has admitted that they used to collect toll from businessmen with the help and cooperation of some local youths.

**Agencies report:** Ashuganj thana police arrested six accused persons of a case filed under PSA on April 14.

It is reported to be the first case in Ashuganj under PSA.

According to police, the accused persons were arrested from Lalpur, Hossainpur vil-

lages in a special raid.

The arrested are Md Mastu Mia, Suman Mia, Rashed Mia, Mohan Mia and Jaijal Mia.
