

Call to pursue reform in power sector

Bangladesh Jatiya Bidyut Sramik Karmachari Union yesterday urged the government to prioritise national interest in pursuing the power sector reforms and ignore irrational pressure and dissatisfaction of the Asian Development Bank (ADB).

In a statement, the Union President Kazi Abdul Halim and General Secretary Md. Jafrud Hasan yesterday said that in the past, the donors compelled the government to form DESA despite protests from the trade unions. Ultimately, the creation of DESA has worsened the condition of the power sector.

They said that the ADB was now pressuring the government to privatise the Power Grid Company of Bangladesh (PGCB) and the National Load Dispatch Centre (NLDC). The leaders termed this move as a step against the interest of the nation considering the security implication of both the PGCB and NLDC.

Instead of trying to reduce system loss and increase revenue through appropriate reforms, the donors are irrationally emphasising on privatising power generation and distribution which is a risky affair, the press statement said.

They further said that if all organisations including DESA paid back PDB all their dues, PDB would have been able to invest in power generation and distribute power independently.

Govt urged to ban 'Londoni Koinya'

Sylhet Bibhag Jubo Parishad (SBJP) threatened yesterday to launch tough movement if 'Londoni Koinya' a drama is not banned.

Describing the drama as anti-language, culture, tradition and lifestyle of Sylhet, the SBJP leaders also demanded legal steps against all concerned.

The demand came from a rally held yesterday at Muktangan in the city with SBJP Convenor Mohammad Moinuddin in the chair. Among others, Advocate Abed Rajab, former secretary Imam Ahmed Chowdhury, Abdul Mannan Abed, Faizur Rahim and Sonar Hossain Sanowar addressed the rally.

Stating that they do not have honour and dignity who took position in favour of the drama, the speakers urged them to refrain from such activities.
