A peace rally was brought out on the occasion from Jatiya Press Club, which ended at National Museum premises. Minister for CHT Affairs Kalparanjan Chakma led the march.

The rally was followed by a gathering in front of the National Museum, which was addressed, among others, by Kalparanjan Chakma and State Minister for Religious Affairs Maolana Nurul Islam.

The speakers stressed the need for establishing a peaceful world following the ideals of Lord Buddha. "Peace is the key factor for development, particularly for a developing country," the rally concluded.

3-day meeting of Red Cross, Red Crescent Societies

The biennial meeting of secretary generals of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies of South Asia Region begins in Cox's Bazar today, reports UNB.

Killing of JU student Probe report placed before Syndicate

The probe report of Ananda Killing incident was placed before the Jahangirnagar University (JU) Syndicate at a special session on Tuesday 20 months after the report was submitted.

The Syndicate members will give their opinion on the report and it will be forwarded to the university disciplinary committee for taking action against the persons involved.

Ananda Kumar Ghosh, a second year student of Economics Department and worker of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), was shot on October 18, 1997. He died on November 2 at Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Sources said the killing of Ananda was a sequel to intra-party clash over establishing dominance on the campus.

The rival group attacked A.F.M. Kamaluddin Hall at about 2.00 pm on October 18. They shot him in his right thigh and chest after stabbing him in front of Room No 319.

The university authorities formed a three-member probe committee with Prof Ismail Hossain as its head. The two other members were the then Proctor Asfar Ahmad and former Proctor Prof M Nasiruddin.

The probe report was submitted to the then Vice Chancellor Prof Alauddin Ahmed on September 13, 1998.

US Air Force chief in city

The Commanding General of the 13th Air Force of the US Pacific Air Forces Major General Daniel M Dick arrived yesterday on a five-day visit to Bangladesh, reports BSS.
