An M.Sc final year student of Jahangirnagar University (JU) died after being run over by a minibus at Kataban in the city Friday night.

The student identified as Akhtaruzzaman Sajal, was a final year student of the Statistics Department.

Sources said, Sajal was run over by the bus while crossing the road near the Planning Academy at Kataban at about 9.00 pm.

Passers-by took him to Dhaka Medical College Hospital where he died later in the night.

JU VC Prof Abdul Bayes and teachers of Statistics Department, in a press release yesterday expressed deep shock at Sajal's death.
