Appointment of CEC: Tofail, Sayeed blast Khaleda Zia

Industries Minister Tofail Ahmed yesterday said opposing everything of Sheikh Hasina's government is the politics of Khaleda Zia and "that's why she is opposing the appointment of new CEC."

"Had BNP secretary general Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan been appointed the CEC, Begum Khaleda Zia would have opposed it," the ruling Awami League leader told UNB.

His reaction came on the heels of a reported statement of opposition leader Begum Khaleda Zia that new CEC M A Syed was a governor during the BKSAL period.

"I'm surprised by such an untrue and misleading comment from a person who was country's Prime Minister and is now Leader of the Opposition," said Tofail.

He said M A Syed was not a governor during the period of Krishak Samik Awami League when Bangabandhu was leading the second revolution. Syed was a director of the BJMC at that time which is recorded," he said.

Referring to a recent meeting between Khaleda Zia and former secretary Mofazzal Karim, the minister said Karim was appointed governor of Gopalganj and now she is welcoming him to her party.

"However, by welcoming a governor Begum Zia proved that the governors were not bad elements... Had it been true that Mr Syed was a governor, that would not have been bad," Tofail said.

He said General Ziaur Rahman had congratulated the governor and they still have the congratulatory letters.

Describing M A Syed as a very honest, undisputed and efficient ex-bureaucrat, the minister said Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina opted for him in consultation with President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed.

"The Prime Minister had wanted a CEC also after consulting with the opposition leader. First Begum Zia refused to sit with the Prime Minister and then destroyed the path of dialogue by making a statement at a public meeting in Kurigram," Tofail said.

Another report adds: Sharply reacting to a statement of Begum Khaleda Zia, State Minister for Information Prof Abu Sayeed today said he was a governor, not the new Chief Election Commissioner, M A Syed.

"Begum Zia will have to seek apology to the countrymen for her such misleading statement," the minister said in a statement.

He said M A Syed was not among the governors appointed by Bangabandhu on July 16, 1975. "I was appointed a governor of Pabna, not the newly elected CEC M A Syed."

Prof Sayeed also sent a copy of the congratulatory letter he received from the then deputy chief of army staff Major General Ziaur Rahman. Zia signed the letter congratulating him and praying to Allah so that he can serve the country with courage and strength.

Confinement of 3 BSEHR probe report sent to defence secy

Bangladesh Society for the Enforcement of Human Rights (BSEHR) yesterday sent to the defence secretary its investigation report on 'illegal confinement of three persons inside Savar Cantonment for one month and two days', BSEHR sources said.

The incident came to light when Maksud Begum of Sri Khandia village in Ashulia area in Savar lodged a complaint with BSEHR on Sunday that army personnel from Savar Cantonment picked up her husband Hutanayun Kabir on April 21 and he has been detained there for the last one month.

A five-member investigation team of BSEHR headed by Advocate Alena Khan then probed the incident.

On Monday, Ashar Uddin Shikhar of Ashulia area lodged a complaint with BSEHR that his son Sajib Shikhar has been confined in the Cantonment for the last one month.

The BSEHR probe report suspected that another person identified as Shafiqul Islam has been confined in the Cantonment. However, BSEHR was yet to receive any complaint from any relative of Shafiqul.

"On the basis of information available from different sources, the allegation of Maksud Begum appeared to be true," the probe report said.

BSEHR requested the defence secretary to take immediate steps for 'release of the three innocent persons' and proper action against the persons responsible.

When contacted last night, an ISPR official said that they were not informed of the incident.
