### Over 100 fall sick eating lunch

MOULVIBAZAR, May 27: More than 100 people including six newsmen fell sick recently when they ate 'packet lunch supplied in the centenary celebration function of Kali Prashad High School at Munshibazar of Kamalgoni thana.

Local physicians said food poisoning was its reason. The school centenary celebration committee alleged that the 'packet lunch' for the function was purchased from a famous restaurant here named 'Bengal Food, and they had supplied the poisonous food.

The victims of food poisoning included Aminur Rashid Babar, district correspondent of the Daily Ittefaque, Nurul Islam, editor of local weekly Pata Kurir Desh, Sarwar Ahmed, district correspondent of Dainik Manab Jamin. Syed Humayed Ali Shahin, district correspondent of Dainik Janakantha, S M Umed Ali, correspondent of BNA, Pramit Ranjan Debnath. Kamalgonj correspondent of Dainik Matribhumi and Abdul Motaleb Tarafder, president of Munshibazar Businessmen Association.

The worst affected villages under Sadar upazila are - Char Pauli, Kakuh Gopal Keutil and few villages of Salla, Arjuna and Ganbshara unions under Bhuapur.

In Jhalakathi, Rajapur and Kathalia upazilas of the district have been facing a threat due to erosion of the river Bishkhali.

# Forged notes flood N dists

KURIGRAM, May 27: Forged cerned sources. currency notes of different denominations have flooded the markets of 16 northern districts creating a serious panic among the members of the pub-

It is alleged that forged currency notes of over Tk five crore of 50, 100 and 500 denominations have been channeled across the country with due precaution by a strong Mafia
