Safe Motherhood Day 2000 United efforts needed to reduce maternal mortality rate

Health and Family Welfare Minister Sheikh Fazlul Karim Selim yesterday emphasised the need for creating mass awareness for reducing maternal mortality rate and ensure maternal health in the country, reports BSS.

People from all walks of life, irrespective of their opinions, should be united to carry forward the programmes undertaken by the government to reduce maternal mortality rate and create awareness among the people across the country," he said.

The minister said this while inaugurating the national communication and social mobilisation programme on "Reduction of Maternal Mortality and Violence Against Women," organised by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare at the Osmani memorial auditorium in the city in observance of Safe Motherhood Day 2000.

Chaired by Health and Family Welfare Secretary Syed Alamgir Farook Chowdhury, the function was addressed by State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Prof Dr M Amanullah, UNICEF representative in Bangladesh Shahida Azfar, DG, Health Directorate Prof ABM Ahsanullah, DG, Family Planning Directorate, Shauddin Ahmed and Joint Secretary of the Ministry of Health Abdus Salam.

Selim said the government of Sheikh Hasina has undertaken up various programmes aimed at reducing maternal mortality rate.

"We are implementing two projects — Bangladesh Integrated Nutrition Programme (BIMP) and National Nutrition Programme (NNP) — involving Taka 632 crore to ensure safe motherhood in the country," he added.

Giving an overview of the government's programmes in this regard, he said 13,500 community clinics are being constructed across the country to provide adequate healthcare services to the people.

The government has so far established 90 Maternal and Children Welfare Centres with

modern medicare facilities including blood transfusion and basic obstetrics across the country to ensure safe motherhood.

The health minister called upon all including NGO workers and media personnel to come forward for creating mass awareness among the people across the country to reduce rate of maternal mortality.

State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Prof Dr M Amanullah said that the maternal mortality rate in Bangladesh is very high compared to any developed country.

A video on Safe Motherhood was screened for the audience at the beginning of the programme.

JU admission tests from June 7-15

Admission tests of the first year honours classes under the academic session 1999-2000 of Jahangirnagar University (JU) will be held from June 7 to 15, official sources said.

The decision was taken at a meeting of the university Academic Council recently.

Admission tests of 'Ka' unit (Science Faculty) will begin June 7. The tests for 'Mathematics,' 'Geological Science,' 'Environmental Science' and 'Electronics and Computer Science' department will be held on the day while admission tests of 'Statistics,' 'Physics' and 'Chemistry' departments will be held the following day.

The admission tests of 'Cha' unit (Life Science Institute) will begin June 10. The exams of 'Botany' and 'Zoology' department will be held on the day. On June 11 the tests of 'Bio-Chemistry and Molecular Biology' and 'Pharmacy' department will be held.

Admission tests of 'Kha' unit (Social Science Faculty) will be held from June 12 to 14. Admission tests of 'Economics' and 'Anthropology' will be held on June 12. 'Government and Politics' and 'Geography and Environment' on June 13, and of 'Urban and Rural Planning' and 'Business Administration' on June 14.

Admission tests of the seven departments under 'Ga' unit (Arts Faculty) will be held from June 14 to 15. Tests of 'International Relations' and 'English' will be held on June 14 while those of 'History,' 'Philosophy,' 'Drama and Dramatics,' 'Archaeology' and 'Bangla' will be held on June 15.

A total of 33048 candidates will vie for about 700 seats in 24 departments under four units this year. Results of the admission tests will be published on July 25.
