Water scarcity in Khulna

KHULNA, June 1: People of the district have been facing acute scarcity of pure drinking water due to shortage of tube-wells, reports UNB.

Public Health Engineering Department (PHED) sources said a total of 1,125 water pumps including 161 deep tube-wells and 915 shallow pumps have long been inoperative in the district.

These pumps could not be repaired or new ones installed due to shortage of funds as the government stopped ADP allocation for rural water supply project here this year.

Forced to drink pond water, people are regularly falling sick due to various kinds of intestinal diseases like diarrhoea and dysentery.

According to health department, at least 3,000 people in the district are attacked by diarrhoea every year due to drinking of unsafe water.

A PHED official said people in the remote areas are not getting water from tube-wells due to sharp fall in the groundwater level during the summer.
