

Mugging incidents on the rise on JU campus

Incidents of mugging have risen to an alarming rate on the Jahangirnagar University (JU) campus in recent days.

Most of these incidents take place on the campus between 9:00 pm to 11:00 pm, sources said. Some incidents also take place in broad day light, sometimes before the very eyes of university security personnel, they added.

'Parijat Nursery' and adjacent areas near the university security office are the places where muggings incidents mostly occur. Other places are the areas near Central Shahed Minar, Botanical Garden and Bismillah Road.

Afsana Khatun, a student of pharmacy dept, was mugged recently on a morning walk with a friend. A young man of about 20 years of age attacked them when they arrived at Jahanara Imam Hall where a security personnel was on duty. The boy however failed to snatch her chain and fled past the security personnel to the nearby 'Parijat Nursery'. Afsana asked the security personnel to go after him

but he said he had no orders to arrest muggers. Later, this security personnel was sacked.

The following day three women, fall victim to such an incident again. Nandita, her mother, a hall-super of Jahanara Imam Hall, and another hall-super were returning to their resident at about 9:00 pm when a snatcher, his face covered with a black mask, attacked them in front of Pritilata's gold chain. He took away Nandita's gold chain.

Unmay Raihan and Monwarul Sultan, two students of Chemistry dept and Tairan Zannat of Drama and Dramatics dept were also mugged during the last two months.

Concerned officials when contacted said that the university is an open place and since there is no boundary wall, all kind of people can roam freely on the campus. Besides, they added, it is quite impossible to tackle intruders and muggers with the poor number of security personnel that the university at present has.

Ban on gatherings around JS from Sunday midnight

The authorities, ahead of the 18th parliament session beginning Monday, has imposed ban from Sunday midnight over a wide area around the Jatiya Sangsad on holding of any gathering, procession, demonstration, carrying of arms, explosive and other harmful materials.

The Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner under two specific articles of the DMP Ordinance has imposed the restriction to ensure smooth running of Sangsad session as well as maintaining peace and discipline in the area, said a press release.

The restricted areas are — Bangla Motor crossing to Mohakhali rail crossing, from Western part of Bangla Motor link road to Sonargaon Road SAARC fountain, from Eastern point of Panthapath to Green Road connecting point to Farmgate, Shyamoli cinema hall to Dhanmondi Road No 27, Agar-rokeya Shishu Mela crossing, Rokeya Swarni connecting point, Rokeya Swarni-Agar-rokeya connecting point to old Nine Division crossing (aeroplane crossing) to Parlatan crossing at Bijoy Swarni, from Eastern point of Indra Road to Western part of Manik Mia Avenue, restricted areas of Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban, Chandrima Udayan and all roads, lanes and by lanes around the EC Secretariat.

The restriction will continue till ending of the 18th session of the 7th Parliament.

Foundation of 'NAM Green' housing complex laid

Accommodation for foreign dignitaries during Dhaka summit

The foundation stone of the 'NAM Green' Housing Complex for accommodation of foreign dignitaries during the Dhaka Summit to the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) next year was laid in the capital yesterday, reports BSS.

Speaker Humayun Rasheed Chowdhury laid the foundation of the Taka 60 crore housing complex on an eight-acre plot at Manik Mia Avenue in front of the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban in the city.

The complex comprises six ten-storied buildings with 216 modern flats. After the summit, one of the buildings will be allocated to Members of Parliament and rest of the flats to government officials.

Addressing as chief guest on the occasion, the Speaker said Parliament Member should play a pivotal role for flourishing democratic culture to give democracy an institutional shape in the country.

He said Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has taken up a number of initiatives to provide the family members of the lawmakers with modern housing facilities so that the MPs could perform their duties smoothly.

Presided over by Housing and Public Works Secretary Sohel Ahmed Chowdhury the function was addressed, among others, by Housing and Public Works Minister Engineer Mosharraf Hossain and local parliamentarian Aliyaz Mokbul Hossain.

Engineer Mosharraf Hossain said the present government has taken initiative to ensure civic facilities by constructing housing projects at district

headquarters and other municipalities across the country.

To expedite the process the government would introduce the National Housing Authority Bill in the coming session of the Jatiya Sangsad, he said.

"We had already rehabilitated about 50,000 people under the Arayan Projects across the country under special initiative of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina," he said and pointed out different welfare activities of the present government like old age pension scheme, allowances for abandoned women and distressed people.

The minister said RAJUK, for the first time, is constructing 230 flats in different areas of the city and another 230 flats will be constructed soon.

He said the Public Works Directorate is also constructing 164 suites with modern facilities in Nakhla para area for NAM conference delegates. These flats will also be allocated to the lawmakers after the summit to solve their long-standing housing problem, he added.

Chhatra Dal, Jatiya Chhatra Samaj, Chhatra Motir and Chhatra Union are boycotting the election.

Iraq-Kuwait war victims UNCC to dispose of compensation cases soon

The United Nations Compensation Commission (UNCC) has assured of disposing of the pending compensation cases of the Iraq-Kuwait War, reports UNB.

The assurance came when Labour and Employment Minister Abdul Mannan, now visiting Geneva to attend the International Labour Conference, met with UNCC Executive Secretary Jean Claude Aimee yesterday, according to a message received in the city.

During the meeting, the Minister thanked the Executive Secretary for the Cooperation UNCC rendered in obtaining compensation for Bangladeshis affected in the Iraq-Kuwait war and for assistance in the disbursement of 288 million US dollar so far.

Mannan requested Aimee for expedition actions with regard to the pending cases of a number of Bangladeshi companies.

CJ to attend conference on legal matters in USA

Justice Bimalendu Bikas Roy Chowdhury, a senior-most judge of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court, will act as the Chief Justice during the absence of Chief Justice Latifur Rahman, reports BSS.

Chief Justice Latifur Rahman, who left city yesterday for the United States at the invitation of the World Bank to attend a conference on legal matters, will visit different courts in the United States and spend with family members.

The three-day conference on "Comprehensive Legal and Judicial Development" will begin on June 5. He will tour different courts to get himself acquainted with "Modern Court Management and Administrative System."

The Chief Justice is expected to return home on July 2. Justice Chowdhury will perform his duty as Chief Justice till the returns home of Chief Justice.
