Environmental laws not working effectively

Local Government Minister Zillur Rahman yesterday said that the environmental laws, formulated to protect environment, were not effectively working due to lack of monitoring system and proper enforcement, reports BSS.

"Though the laws were formulated for maintaining public health and development of environment, there are some structural weaknesses in the effectiveness and enforcement of these laws," he said at a discussion in the city.

Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA) organised the discussion on "Limitations of the Environmental Laws and

Problems of Enforcement" in observance of the World Environment Day.

State Minister for Environment H N Ashikur Rahman, BMA secretary general Dr Mostafa Jalal Mohiuddin, Dr C M Delwar Rana, Dr Salimullah Sayeed and Dr. Laila Anjumana Banu also took part in the discussion while BMA president Dr Rashid-e-Mahbub was in the chair.

Zillur Rahman laid emphasis on identification of the problems of enforcement of environmental laws and to ensure working capacity and accountability of the agencies concerned for enforcement of environmental laws.

Oppositions' seats in JS falling vacant

Ershad to discuss consequences with alliance partners

Jatiya Party will soon meet other parties in the alliance to discuss exigency of joining parliament and to discuss with them the adverse consequences that will arise if the opposition seats fell vacant, reports UNB.

After discussing pros and cons of a situation that might arise following 90 days' absence from the House, the Jatiya Party Parliamentary Party in its meeting yesterday entrusted Ershad to discuss the issue with

the concerned leaders of the 4-party alliance.

"We want to join the parliament and also to take active part in the proceedings, but not at the cost of unity of the alliance," leading JP lawmaker G M Kader told UNB.

The JPPP meeting, presided by H M Ershad, gave responsibility to the party chairman to discuss the matter with the leaders of other parties of the alliance.

During elaborate discussions, the possibility of losing seats following 90 days of absence from parliament also came up.

"Neither do we want to lose our membership nor do we want to give the ruling party such an opportunity," Kader said citing sentiments of JP MPs during the meeting.

Kader, younger brother of Ershad, said the JP chairman, who is leaving for London today evening, has already conveyed

the sentiments of JP lawmakers to BNP leaders and might sit for discussion sometime today.

A follow-up meeting will be held after Ershad's return from London, he said. In the meantime, the JP leadership will take the views of BNP, Jamaat and IOD.

At least 15 MPs, including Leader of the Opposition Khaleda Zia and Jatiya Party chief Ershad, are heading towards the 90-day red mark crossing which may cost them their parliament membership.

The Constitution provides that if a Member of Parliament is absent from parliament, without leave of the House, for 90 consecutive sitting days, then his seat may be declared as vacant.

Parliament Secretariat sources said Khaleda Zia has remained absent for 58 days while Ershad for 54 days as per attendance register maintained by the House.
