Case filed against nine By Court Correspondent. A complaint case was filed against 9 persons including 3 police personnels of Motijheel Thana yesterday with the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's court of Dhaka...

Masummat Farha Begum, a resident of 65/1, DIT Extension Road, Purana Palton, Dhaka filed the case against the nine on charges of illegal trespass, theft, intimidation and misbehaviour.

The 9 accused persons are - Yousuf Ali Khan, Humayun Kabir Talukder, Shek Golam Sarwar, Touhidur Rahman, Rashid, Babul Ahmed Talukder, all residents of Motijheel area, and three police personnel - Abdul Haq, OC of Motijheel Thana, Mahbubur Rahman and Monir, sub-inspectors of the same thana.

Metropolitan Magistrate Biman Behari Barua directed the DMP Commissioner to take legal action after a detailed investigation. In her plaint, Fara Begum said that on May 28 the three police personnels in collusion with other accused came to her residence with firearms, beat up her tenants and damaged valuable worth about Tk 7 lakh.

Among others, Editor of the Bangladesh Observer Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury, Journalist Shafiqur Rahman and general secretary of the Samity Shyamol Dutta took part in the discussion while its president Shamsuddin Ahmed was in the chair.

Muhammad Nasim said earlier he tried to evict illegal slum dwellers but a vested quarter foiled the move for their own interest.
