Citizens express concern over rising terrorism

United Citizens Society holds mass rally at Shaheed Minar premises

Speakers at a citizen's rally at the central Shaheed Minar yesterday expressed deep concern over the rising number of criminal activities in the country, including terrorism, extortion, crimes, rape and repression on women.

They said that the entire society seems to have been taken hostage by a small number of criminals who are openly unleashing criminal activities and regretted that almost no one was being brought to book or being punished.

Hundreds of activists of different social organisations from the capital and its suburbs attended the rally organised by United Citizens Society (Oikyabaddha Nagarik Samaj), a newly floated citizens' front to express their determination free the society from poverty, terrorism, extortion, crime, fundamentalism and repression on women.

In his presidential speech, National Professor Kabir Chowdhury, the convener of the society, said that widespread terrorism and criminal activities throughout the country is threatening peace and security of life in general. He said, "We want to build a democratic society where there will be no terrorism and exploitation."

Chowdhury also stressed on the need for development of women and children, as they are the main victims of repression. "We will be able to attain all our goals with more ease if they come forward and support us."

He called on the prime minister to take immediate action against terrorists, rapists and criminals.

Other participants condemned the government for not taking effective initiatives to curb terrorism. They added that radical and communal forces are engaged in creating anarchy in the country in the name of religion and are openly identifying themselves as "Taliban" and daring to create another "Afghan" nation.

They called on both AL and opposition BNP not to compromise with religious fanatics for political purposes.

The members of different social organisations said that this "ferocious" sector was hindering education and development efforts in the country. They observed with concern that most of these criminals are affiliated to major political parties. In some cases police are also patronising them.

Among others, Syed Shamsul Haq, Abed Khan, Khushi Kabir, Ajay Ray, Hasanul Haq Inu, Abdul Mannan, Monjurul Ahsan Khan, Hashem Khan, Rowshan Zahana Shathi, Anwara Begum, Fatema Begum also addressed the rally.

They stressed on the aim to establish rule of law in the society and build a nation in the light of the spirit of liberation war.

Later, the participants brought out a large procession from the Shaheed Minar premises and marched to the Prime Minister's Office to submit a memorandum to her.

Outgoing Saudi envoy calls on Shahabuddin

President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed has hoped that Bangladesh and Saudi Arabia will continue to work together for peace, progress and stability of the world, and the prosperity of their two peoples, reports UNB.

The President made the remarks when Saudi Ambassador to Bangladesh Abdullah Omar Barry made a farewell call on him at Bangabhaban yesterday. Shahabuddin appreciated the Saudi envoy for his efforts in strengthening the bilateral

relations between the two countries and Saudi Arabia's continued support for economic development of Bangladesh. He also expressed satisfaction over Saudi preference given to Bangladeshi manpower.

Omar Barry expressed satisfaction over the existing excellent bilateral relations between Saudi Arabia and Bangladesh, and hoped that the brotherly relations between the two countries would be diversified in future.

JU admission tests begin tomorrow

No classes from June 7- July 7

Admission tests into first year honours classes under the academic session 1999-2000 of Jahangirnagar University (JU) will begin tomorrow.

This year, a total of 33048 candidates are competing for 7000 seats in 24 departments under four faculties with nearly 47 of them vying for each seat. Of them, 8830 will compete for the seats under 'Ka' unit (Science Faculty), 9800 for 'Kha' unit (Social Science Faculty), 6413 for 'Ga' unit (Arts Faculty) and 8005 for 'Gha' unit (Life Science Institute).

Admission tests of 'Ka' unit will begin tomorrow. On the very first day, admission tests of 'Mathematics', 'Geological Science', 'Environmental Science', 'Electronics and Computer Science' and 'Statistics Dept' will be held. The admis-

sion tests of 'Physics' and 'Chemistry Dept' will take place the following day.

On June 10, admission tests of 'Gha' unit will begin with tests for the Botany and Zoology depts. Admission tests of 'Bio-Chemistry and Molecular Biology' and 'Pharmacy' will be held on the next day.

Admission tests of 'Kha' unit will be held from June 12 to 14. Admission tests of 'Economics' and 'Anthropology' will be held on June 12 while 'Government and Politics', and 'Geography and Environment' on June 13, and 'Urban and Regional Planning' the following day.

Admission tests of 'Ga' unit will begin on June 14 with 'International Relations' and 'English'. Admission tests of 'History', 'Philosophy', 'Drama and Dramatics', 'Archaeology' and 'Bangla' depts will be held on June 15.

No classes will be held at Jahangirnagar University (JU) from tomorrow to July 6 due to summer vacation and admission tests, official sources said.

Classes will remain suspended from June 7 to 15 due to first year admission tests.




