Speakers at Sramik Dal discussion

No alternative to politics of production

Jatiyatabadi Sramik Dal, the labour front of BNP, organised a discussion titled "Zia — the worker" on the occasion of 19th death anniversary of Ziaur Rahman, at Jatiya Press Club yesterday.

Presided over by Sramik Dal President and BNP's joint secretary general Abdullah Al Noaman, it was addressed, among others, by BNP secretary general Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan, MP, Col (Retd) Akbar Hossain, MP, Major (Retd) Hafizuddin Ahmed, MP, Shamsuzzaman

Dudu, MP, Journalist Amanul Kabir, Sramik Dal leaders Abul Kashem Chowdhury, Nazrul Islam Khan, Nurul Islam Nasim, Shahidul Islam Chowdhury Dalal, BM Baki and Alamgir Majumder.

Speaker said Ziaur Rahman didn't take the power willingly rather the state power was imposed on this valiant freedom fighter and he held the helm of the nation with courage and ran the state affairs efficiently.

Zia protected the nation from serious crisis through declaring the independence in 1971 and restoring democratic process, establishing multi-party democracy and rule of law, ensuring freedom of speech and fundamental rights after the political change over in 1975, they said.

Speakers further said the late resident succeeded in making Bangladesh a self-reliant country from the basket case through introducing policies of production and making the peaceful revolution in the fields of mass education, agriculture, industry and family planning.

Terming Zia as the architect of modern Bangladesh, they said he was a man of vision and successful in placing the country in a dignified position in the world through his vision, far-sightedness, tireless efforts, courage, self-dignity and able leadership.

They said the Awami-BKSLA rulers destroyed the country through looting of people's wealth, corruption and repression and Zia rescued the nation from the ruin. The AL does not want to recognise the contribution of Ziaur Rahman who hid its misdeeds, failures and autocratic activities.

NU Honours part III exams

Candidates' mass protest rally tomorrow

Honours part III students forced suspension of classes at Eden College and staged a sit-in demonstration in front of Dhaka College yesterday as part of their continuing movement demanding rescheduling of their part III final exams under National University (NU).

The students of different colleges under National University have also decided to hold a grand rally on June 8 at the Central Shaheed Minar to voice their demand.

According to sources, students brought out processions at different colleges including Dhaka College, Eden College, Jagannath College, Titumir College and Gazipur Bhawal Badre Alam College yesterday to press for their demand.

Students of Eden College forced the authorities to close the college. Similar situation prevails at Jagannath College and Titumir College, sources said.

At Dhaka College, agitating students demonstrated on the campus in favour of their demand and laid siege to the room of the college principal. The principal later held a meeting with the students to bring the situation under control.

According to students, the principal admitted that there is not a single department in the college which has completed more than 30 per cent of the courses as per the NU syllabus.

Dhaka College principal also informed the students that the National University (NU) authorities will shortly had a meeting with all of college principals to discuss the issue.
