Rasul arrives today

The body of Justice Md Iftekhar Rasul will be brought this morning from London by Bangladesh Biman, reports BSS.

Justice Rasul, a judge of the High Court Division of the Supreme Court died at a British hospital on Tuesday following open heart surgery.

His body will be taken to his village home for burial at family graveyard in Comilla following namaz-e-Janaza in Kakkrali.

Meanwhile, Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Abdul Matin Khasru condoled the death of Justice Rasul.

In a message Khasru said Justice Rasul contributed to the enrichment of legal system in the country.
