
DU Senate session

USTC imparts quality education
Dhaka campus opens with new subjects

Speakers at a meeting yesterday praised the success of Bangladesh medical professionals at home and abroad and said that Bangladesh's efficiency in different medical disciplines have been recognised around the world.

"Bangladeshi medical pro-

fessionals have proved their skill in medical science as well as teaching and earned a distinction in the field," National Professor Nurul Islam said while addressing the opening ceremony of the Dhaka Campus of University of Science and Technology Chittagong (USTC).

Prof Islam, who is the founder vice-chancellor of the university said that USTC has already earned a good reputation in foreign countries, and about 33 per cent of its students are from abroad.

"This has been made possible due to discharge of quality education and the total dedication of its staff members," he said.

Earlier, Prof Nurul Islam briefly described the establishment of the country's first ever private sector university on science and technology, established at Chittagong in 1992.

He said that the Dhaka Campus has been launched with three courses on Computer Science, Executive MBA and Family Medicine Diploma.

Industries Minister Tofail Ahmed, who attended the function as chief guest lauded the success of Bangladeshi medical professionals at home and abroad.

The minister stressed upon the need of expansion of IT education and hoped that the USTC will be able to produce prospective manpower in the IT sector to contribute to the national development.

The minister said that IT had now become the most important part of global affairs and the present government had given top priority to its rapid development in the greater national interest.

The Industries Minister highly appreciated the venture of Prof Nurul Islam in establishing an institute dedicated to promotion and teaching of medical science and said "A world renowned physician and educationist like him will always remain a source of inspiration for others in such fields."

Local Government Minister Zillur Rahman yesterday hoped that the participatory water management regulations would help implement the government water policies ensuring participation of people, reports UNB.

He said participation of the people would be a milestone in proper and integrated use of water resources.

The minister was addressing the inaugural function of a daylong workshop on the draft policies of "Participatory Water Management" at Agargaon LGED auditorium. Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzaq also addressed the function.

Local Government Secretary Badrur Rahman, Water Resources Secretary Dr ATM Shamsul Huda, WDB Chairman Golam Rabbani, LGED Chief Engineer Monwar Hossain Chowdhury and participatory water management policy formulation organisation Inter-Agency Task Force convenor Shahidul Hasan took part in the discussion.

Meanwhile 8 "fake" examinees were expelled yesterday on the third day of the JU admission tests.


Dacoity at

Terms & Conditions:

3. Tenderer must submit a realistic work plan showing all the items of work and time to be required.
4. All the tender must enclose the attested photo copy of licence (enlistment), TIN & VAT registration certificate along with the tender, otherwise the tender will be summarily rejected. Successful tenderer have to submit their original licence, TIN & VAT Registration Certificates during submitting the formal tenders which will be returned after issuance of work order.
5. The tender shall quote the rate against each item of works mentioned in the schedule of items both in figure & in words. Overwriting, use of fluids or erasing by any means will not be accepted.
6. The tenderer must submit detail analysis of every items of works quoted by him/himself in the tender schedule. Tender without analysis, and tender with photocopy, carbon copy of analysis, overwriting, use of fluid or erasing by any means will not be accepted.
7. VAT & Income Tax will be deducted from the bill of the contractor as per rule of National Board of Revenue on the gross amount of bill. In the rate analysis, the accurate percentage of VAT & IT must be included by the contractor with detailed break up. The tender must put signature on all pages of tender documents.
8. The tenderer must include the cost of lab tests fee mentioned in the tender schedule in the rate and should be shown in the analysis of items.
9. The cost of mobilization, materials, equipments, temporary shed at site etc. must be considered during the quoting of rate of items. No separate item will be entertained for such nature of work.
10. No separate rate should be quoted for shoring, dewatering, ringbunch and artificial island but cost of the same should be considered during quoting the rate of earthwork.
11. No additional work will be allowed without prior approval or written permission from the competent authority. Contractor will be solely responsible for such type of additional works.
12. The successful tenderer must start the work within 10 (ten) days from the date of issuance of work order. If the contractor fails to start work within 10 days, necessary action will be taken for cancellation of work order.
13. Any case of subletting or syndicating by any contractors/firms will cause the cancellation of tender or pre-qualification or both.
14. This tender notice is precise, other detailed information regarding tender bid in question could be collected from the office of the undersigned during office hours.
15.
