Copyright Bill-2000**

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Ministry of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs in a meeting yesterday finalised the Copyright Bill-2000 after detailed discussion for placing it to the Jatiya Sangsad, reports BSS.
