A total of 2694 disabled artistes received government donations in the past five years. The yearly grant of Taka 50 lakh for such artistes however has remained the same despite the number of such artistes increasing each year.

This was disclosed in parliament yesterday by State Minister for Sports and Cultural Affairs Obaidul Quader.

The number of disabled artistes covered by the charity programme was 599 in 1996-97 and rose to 641 the following year.

Assam MPs call on President Parliament can play vital role in development

He thanked the President for receiving him and the members of the delegation.

Bangladesh Jatiya Sangsad Secretary Quazi Monzur-i-Mowla and Secretary to the President Muhammad Ismail Hossain were present on the occasion.

Electoral law reform

Call to implement recommendations of FEMA

Leaders of five different organisations yesterday demanded immediate implementation of the recommendations on electoral law reforms formulated by the Fair Election Monitoring Alliance (FEMA), reports UNB.

Leaders of POROSH, WBL Institute for Environment and Development, JESH Foundation and Kranti Sangsads in a joint statement said, "we are fully agreed with FEMA's recommendations for reforming laws pertaining to the election to parliament and strongly demand immediate implementation of the recommendations for ensuring free, fair and meaningful elections.

Expressing solidarity with FEMA's initiative regarding the reforms of election law, they also urged the political leadership to extend their support to the endeavour of FEMA for bringing about positive changes in the electoral process across the country.

They said that like FEMA they also believe that the democratic and credible elections make better informed and more involved citizens, political leadership and increased legitimacy of democratic process and institutions, which eventually lead a country towards socio-economic and political prosperity, said a press release.

Nat'l flag to be hoisted to mark Eid-e-MiladunNabi

The national flag will be hoisted atop all government and private buildings on Thursday when *Eid-e-MiladunNabi* will be observed across the country, reports UNB.

All concerned have been requested to fly the flag on time and lower at sunset, a said an official announcement yesterday.

It is a public holiday. As of other institutions, all post offices will remain closed on the day, but the post offices having GEP or EMS services will operate to provide the services as usual.

There will be a consecutive three-day closure as the public holiday for *MiladunNabi*, marking the birth and demise of Prophet Hazrat Muhammad (SM), falls on Thursday leading to weekend on Friday and Saturday.

"In view of this three-day closure, postal department has made a special arrangement to deliver non-registered letters and sell envelopes and stamps from the RMS office (mail & sorting) counters on Saturday," said a handout.

Various government and non-government organisations have taken up programmes, including *Milad* and discussion on the occasion.

Flood situation may remain static in Sunamganj

Flood situation in Sunamganj district may remain unchanged in the next 24 hours as rivers in the Meghna basin marked rise and fall yesterday, reports UNB.

The Surma rose by 16 cm at Sylhet and 9 cm at Sunamganj while it was flowing above danger level by 33 cm at Sunamganj, according to a bulletin of the Flood Forecasting and Warning Centre (FFWC).

The Manu registered rise by 25 cm at Manu Railway Bridge and by 13 cm at Moulvibazar, the Khawali rose by 48 cm at Habiganj, Someswari 10 cm at Durgapur and Meghna 8 cm at Bairab Bazar.

In the Brahmaputra basin, the Brahmaputra and Jamuna marked rise at upstream while the Padma also rose at all points. The rivers in the South-Eastern Hill Basin showed rise and fall.

Out of 46 water level measuring stations across the country, 24 points recorded rise, seven registered fall and two remained steady in the last 24 hours till 9 am today.
