270 Ashrayan Projects implemented so far: PM

JS told

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday told the Jatiya Sangsad that so far 270 Ashrayan Projects have been implemented in the country to rehabilitate the distressed people, reports BSS.

Replying to a question from Treasury Bench member Mohammad Tajul Islam, the Prime Minister said another 160 Ashrayan Projects are in the process of implementation. She said that a total of 86,300 landless people from 17,260 families have been rehabilitated in 1,726 Ashrayan Project. She said that the project has been implemented in 175 upazilas in 57 districts.

Sheikh Hasina further informed the House that a place called Lalchandpur under Laksham upazila of Comilla district has been incorporated in the Ashrayan Project to rehabilitate the landless people there. She said the place is being raised above the flood level under a project. She said 20 families would be rehabilitated in two Ashrayan houses there after completion of earth filling work.

Meanwhile, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina also informed the Jatiya Sangsad that 1,197 crippled freedom fighters and families of 2,538 martyred freedom fighters have been getting government allowances on a regular basis.

Replying to a question from Kazi Sirajul Islam (Faridpur-1), she said every crippled freedom fighter moving on wheel chairs, are getting Taka 6,044 per month, while the injured freedom fighters getting a monthly allowance ranging from Taka 1,816 to Taka 2,404 per month.

She said that each of the families of martyred freedom fighters are receiving Taka 1,900 per month. Besides, she said each of the families are also receiving Taka 3,200 annually for meeting the educational expenses of two children. She said that Taka 38,400 is given as lump sum grant for the marriage ceremony of two daughters. They also get two festival bonuses annually.

The Prime Minister further said that the Freedom Fighters

Welfare Trust bears the medical expenses of injured freedom fighters in government hospital.

UNB adds: The much awaited Rooppur Nuclear Power Plant Project would start as early as possible with the availability of fund, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina said in parliament.

Replying to a question of Shamsur Rahman Sharif of Awami League, she said the proposed nuclear power plant is estimated to produce 600 MW electricity. Later, a second plant with a capacity of 600 MW will be set up at the same site.

Tk 40 crore WatSan project launched

NGO Forum for Drinking Water Supply and Sanitation has launched a Tk 40-crore new WatSan project to be completed by June 2004, reports UNB.

The formal launching ceremony of the four and a half years project that began in January this year was held at BETS seminar hall yesterday.

The ceremony was addressed, among others, by Alhaj Quaderuzzaman, Chief Engineer, DPHE, and Preben Gondolf, Counsellor, Danish Embassy with Jowshan A Rahman of NGO Forum in the chair.

The project aims to address threats to sanitation promotion and water resources such as arsenic, declining water table and saline intrusion.

Its other objectives include improving capacity of NGO Forum's partner NGOs and private sector players and ensuring safe, sustainable and affordable water supply to poor and disadvantaged people.

Quaderuzzaman hoped that NGO Forum alongside the WatSan programme would play a vital role in arsenic mitigation. He appreciated Danida for extending their help to the WatSan sector.

Preben Gondolf urged the participants at the launching ceremony to work together to achieve the goal of the WatSan sector.

Jowshan appreciated the NGO Forum for sharing experiences and views with other partner NGOs and sectoral and trans-sectoral agencies.

She also emphasised on maintaining regular collaboration and coordination to avoid any kind of duplication in implementing the WatSan programme.

Potential representatives from relevant ministries, diplomatic missions, donor agencies, UN-bodies, mass media, and national and international NGOs attended the launching ceremony, said a press release.

DU student beaten up on campus

Later, Humayun lodged a complaint with the Vice-Chancellor of the university in this regard. VC Prof AK Azad Chowdhury asked the Detective Branch of Police to raid the hall, but police failed to arrest anyone during the raid at around 11:30 pm.
